#### **Reminders From The Golf Shop**

Seniors play day is every Monday and Friday at 11:30a.m. Please join us for some fun and fellowship for nine holes! If you are planning on playing please call the golf shop.

Ladies Nine-Holers is each Thursday at 10:00AM. Sign up sheet is located in the golf shop or you may call to sign up.

#### Course News:

- 1. Driving range closes each Wednesday at 5:00pm for clean pick which will allow for mowing.
- 2. Carts are permissible on hole number 11, but we ask that you use good judgment, and we ask that you keep your carts at least 30 feet from tees and greens.
- 3. Hole number 3 on the right at the bend is played as a lateral hazard and is marked accordingly.
- 4. Hole number 16 next to the rock wall, marked with blue paint between the wall and flowers is a mandatory drop across the cart path no penalty.
- 5. Hole number 18 concerning Drop Areas. The Drop circles are additional options to the water hazard rule and are not mandatory for relief.

You may proceed under the water hazard rule or you may choose the drop circle options.

Please check with golf shop for clarity or questions.

## Tip of the Month

**RULES:** Ball Unplayable

A player may deem his ball unplayable at any place on the course, except when the ball is in a water hazard. The player is the sole judge as whether his ball is unplayable. If the player deems

his ball to be unplayable, he must, under penalty of one stroke:

- A. Proceed under the stroke and distance provision of rule 27-1 by playing a ball as nearly as possible at the spot from which the original ball was last played, or
- B. Drop a ball behind the point where the ball lay, keeping that point directly between the hole and the spot on which the ball is dropped, with no limit to how far behind that point the ball may be dropped, or
- Drop a ball within two club-lengths of the spot where the ball lay, but not nearer the hole.

If the unplayable ball is in a bunker, the player may proceed under Clause A, B or C. If electing to proceed under B or C, a ball must be dropped in the bunker.
