Tips from the Golf Shop

Focusing on intermediate target!

When you arrive at your chip shot determine your line to the hole by observing the slope in the green. You should then be able to figure out

where you should land the ball to let the ball release to the hole. This would be your intermediate target and should be your focus not the hole! Set your feet and alignment so you are aiming at this point. Take a few practice swings feeling the shot that will land your ball on the intermediate target.

After practicing this method you should become more confident with your short game!!!
