Our club was approached by The Carolinas Golf Association in late 2014 to potentially host the 2015 NC Mid Amateur Championship held in mid September 2015 on Saturday & Sunday with a Friday practice round. The Board pondered our options but had to decline due to our current By-Laws. All voting members should have received a mailing regarding your vote at the May Town Hall Membership meeting to allow 1 event per year, in season, approved by the Board. Tee It Forward Program

Do you wish your approach shot to the green was just a bit easier? Would you rather hit an iron into the green instead of a longer club? If you want to play faster and have more fun, go ahead and move up a set of tees the next time you play! When you TEE IT FORWARD, you'll hit more lofted irons into greens, putt for birdies and pars more often, and play faster and score better!

This program has recommendations based on your tee shot distance, and will help to reach holes in regulation. If you are unsure which tees are recommended for you, find your Driver distance from the chart below. The Tee It Forward program is a recommendation only and is to promote enjoyment of the game.

Driver Distance	Recommended	High Meadows
275	6,700-6,900	Blue
250	6,200-6,400	White
225	5,800-6,000	Gold
200	5,200-5,400	Green
175 or less	4,400-4,600	Red
