The sun is setting on our best membership offer ever!

The Board of Directors, at the recommendation of the 50th An-niversary Committee and the Membership Committee, has approved the following fee schedule: Beginning in September, 2014 and ending December 31, 2014, applicants for membership will be allowed to join for an initiation fee of \$500.00 our standard fee is \$10,000.00. As an additional incentive, the new members who join in Sept, Oct, Nov or Dec. 2014, will be able to start using the facilities at HMG&CC with-out paying dues for those months of 2014. You will pay the \$500 initiation fee plus the dues for 2015, which will be at the 2014 dues rate of \$4,664.00 plus capital dues of \$300.00 all must be paid in full at the time of joining for a total of ONLY \$5464.00. There will be no transfer fees for home owners or road fees for any non-High Meadow Estates residents.

Any former members who wish to rejoin the Club may do so with outstanding past yearly dues excused if they rejoin from September, 2014 to December 31, 2015. All other unpaid debt (road fees, dining and monies owed to the Pro Shop) must be paid before a past member will be allowed to rejoin. Returning members must also pay the \$500 initiation fee.

Tip of the Month

Tip of the month: "Playing In Wind"

When the wind is in your face:

Solid contact is critical. Though your instinct will be to swing a little harder, you'll want to

actually do the opposite. Focus more on tempo and balance. Take a practice swing that feels about 80% of your normal tempo. Your backswing should be a bit abbreviated and your follow through will as well. When you're ready to hit, position the ball back in your stance a bit to hit a lower trajectory. Take at least one extra club (depending on the strength of the wind) to account for the shorter swing and the headwind.

Remember that wind blowing into you enhances the curvature of the ball, so shots that have movement left and right will move even further in those directions. So find the line that



can be safe whether straight or accounting for the wind and focus on the smooth, shorter swing to hit it there.

Roasted Butternut Squash Soup

- 2 qts. of Chicken Stock
- 1 Can Coconut Milk
- 2 lg. Butternut Squash
- 1 med. Chopped Carrot
- 1 Yellow Onion
- 2 tbs. Brown Sugar
- 3 Cloves of Garlic
- 1 tsp. Chinese five Spice
- 1 oz. Grated Ginger
- 2 tbs. Whole Butter
- 1. Roast Butternut Squash with olive oil, salt & pepper. Cook at 400° until brown.
- In heavy bottom sauce pan sauté onion, carrot, ginger & garlic until tender. Add chicken stock; add roasted squash after you peel the skins off.
- 3. Cook on high heat for 45 min. then blend until smooth.
- 4. Season with salt & pepper, Chinese five spice and brown sugar.
- Garnish with crème fraiche, cloves and drizzle with olive oil.
