
General Managers Message

TIP OF THE MONTH! SIDE HILL LIE

- 1. Aim towards the high part of the hill as your ball will always favor the opposite direction.
- 2. Always take practice swings and pay attention to where the club sweeps the grass that will determine the appropriate ball position for the lie.
- 3. Ball above your feet: Club up and choke up.
- Ball below your feet: any move up and out of your posture will result in a thin, missed shot. Bend your knees and stay there.
