A few new changes we will be implementing this fall, the first will be starting on hole number 10. The cart path leading to the first tee had to be removed for the clubhouse expansion and starting on the tenth hole will help the traffic flow and ease play heading to the first hole. Please take extra care heading to the first hole by the practice putting green. Directional signs will be posted for assistance.

This year the golf staff will be using a brand-new tee sheet handicap peer review program called Cap Patrol. This program will send an email to each player in your foursome the next day verifying scores. Cap Patrol will also measure a player's "hot "or "not" status heading into club events. This new program will be a great way to keep all players posting accurate scores and in a timely manner. The Cap Patrol program has been installed in many clubs with tremendous success rate of player posting. Many hours of planning and prepping go into our schedule. We are very proud of our events and fellowship with all members. Remember to post all your scores and use the Golf Genius app when possible.

Thank you for all your summer support!! The staff has done a great job of preparing and we still have much to do as the clubhouse goes through its transformation. Please be patient as we navigate through the Pro Shop/ cart barn check in process. Things will be changing every week. Keep it in the fairway because they are perfect!!

Dear Waterlefe Golf Club Members & Residents:

I would like to first thank everyone for your patience this summer. The staff has heard the comment many times about missing Waterlefe and I assure you, the staff has missed you too! Now is the time to play at your home course again and I am confident you will quickly realize why you have missed playing Waterlefe so much.

Over the past month, the maintenance staff has also increased cultural practices to improve the smoothness of the putting surface. The goal has always been to have complete turfgrass coverage and a smooth putting surface when we re-open. We will continue to push turfgrass growth through October and until dormancy begins. This means the green speed will not be as fast as you normally see in the winter but it will be comparable to what our green speed is normally at this time of year. The green speed will pick up as the cooler temperatures arrive. It also needs to be acknowledged that the greens will be very firm, which will be the biggest change from last season. New greens are always firm and there is no way around it. You will quickly notice that you will need to adjust your yardage to accommodate for the firm greens. The greens will become more receptive to approach shots as time goes on, but it will be 1.5 to 2 years until the greens are fully mature.

Work still continues on the Golf Clubhouse and Cart Barn.











With work continuing on the Golf Clubhouse and Cart Barn, we will require changes to normal traffic patterns. Below is a map showing you what to expect when you arrive at the club. We ask for everyone's assistance to promote a safe and smooth traffic pattern.



I would also like to remind everyone that we will require all golfers to pair up in club carts. Additionally, I would ask that those in private carts allow golfers to pair up in your carts as well. Owners of private carts are not required to pair up at this time but doing so is best for the golf course. Pay attention to the condition of the fairways the next time you play and you will see how the quality of the turfgrass has improved with no traffic. The more we can reduce traffic on the course the better the overall conditions will be.
