As the winter months approach, it's essential to start needling tine greens which aids in the movement of water and getting air down into the root system. This process will help with water movement and allow air to reach the root system. Additionally, monthly pigment applications will commence in November on fairways to maintain their color during the winter season. This is strictly a colorant that will define fairways through the winter. One of our greens, Number 6, has been affected by Pythium blight, a moisturerelated disease. We continue to spray fungicides weekly to address the issue, and have also added plugs to promote growth in the affected area.

Since we have reopened, we have seen an unusual number of unfilled divots. In order to keep our pristine playing conditions day in and day out we all must be proactive at filling divóts. If you take a divot, fill it. If you see one that has not been filled, fill it. If you have a shot away from the cart, please take a scoop of sand or sand bottle with you. Our carts have two bottles and two buckets of sand, so there is no excuse to not fill divots. For those with private carts, we are happy to fill your cart up with sand as often as you need it. There are also bottles you can swap out at both comfort stations on the course. The golf maintenance staff will also maintain the par three tees. Please help by taking a scoop/bottle with you at the time of play. Secondly, we just completed a complete renovation of our greens. Even though they are firm, our putting greens do receive ball marks that need to repaired. The golf staff will be happy to assist and show the proper way to fix. We will be having a series of videos regarding course care and etiquette. <u>Click Here</u> n our first video on how to fill a divot.



# Waterlefe Youth Golf Program November 2023 Update

We now have 15 kids (which has been our goal and is our max) enrolled in our program. The last 5 are a result of our partnering with Big Brothers Big Sisters of the Sun Coast to include their kids that want to learn to play golf and have BB or BS that play golf as well. This is a result of the "Taste of Golf" that we conducted at their "back to school" event in August.

We continue to conduct lessons on Sundays at 3pm rotating through driving range, chipping, putting and then on the course. Matt Primrose, our PGA Pro, is the lead instructor with assistance from Denny Meskill, Sue Owens and myself. We are using the US Kids program in which the kids get tested on the various skills and receive achievement pins as they progress.

We looking for a few more Mentors for each of the kids to enrich their golfing experience. Steve Glynn, a new Waterlefe member, has started the process to become a Big Brother/Golf Mentor for one of the boys in our program. We still have 3 girls and 4 boys and their parent(s) that are interested in having a golfing Mentor. Our Mentoring program is in conjunction with Big Brothers/Big Sisters of the Sun Coast. Here is an overview of the Program:

Purpose:

- Create and support one-to-one mentoring relationships that ignite the power and promise of youth
- To enrich the golfing experience for the boys and girls enrolled in the WYGP
- To encourage continued involvement in learning golf
- To have "fun" with golf, as well as, reinforce US Kids lessons and the values of the WYGP (go to WaterlefeYouthGolfProgram.com for additional information)

#### What's required:

- Meeting the parents and kids in the WYGP program (profile for each kid will be provided ahead of time)

- Matching with compatible parent(s) and kid
- Completing the Big Brother's Big Sisters (BB/BS) process and complying with their program requirements

- BB/B'S process takes 6 to 8 weeks to complete, process includes interviews, background check, fingerprinting and references

- Spending a minimum of 4 hours/month (BB/BS requirement) with your kid playing golf, as well as, other activities

Opportunities:

- River Run Golf Links in Bradenton provides access to their course, after 5pm, to play up to 9 holes for free, when available (including cart).

- Waterlefe Golf Members can take their kids on the Waterlefe course on a time available basis, as well. BB/BS, who are not members at Waterlefe, will have access to the Waterlefe course once per month to play up to 9 holes on a time available basis at no cost.

WYGP Support:

-Diane DeGennaro is the Mentoring coordinator

-WYGP golf shirts and US Kids booklets will be provided for Mentor

-Kids have clubs, shirts and hats and we will provide golf balls and tees


-For kids that are participating in PGA Jr League, we will cover the cost of the program and provide any additional equipment
