**MAY HOLIDAYS**

**May 6th - Cinco de Mayo**

On May 5, 1862, the Mexican army defeated the French army at the Battle of Puebla. This single military battle signified defeat of a European colonial power, and a victory for the Mexican people. This single battle was the roots of Cinco de Mayo. What Cinco de Mayo has come to be, is much more than one battle in the colonial history of Mexico. Rather, it has come to signify Hispanic and Mexican pride and a time to celebrate the rich culture.

**May 10th - Mother's Day**

Mother's Day is a holiday honoring motherhood that is observed in different forms throughout the world. The American incarnation of Mother's Day was created by Anna Jarvis in 1908 and became an official U.S. holiday in 1914. Jarvis would later denounce the holiday's commercialization and spent the latter part of her life trying to remove it from the calendar. While dates and celebrations vary, Mother's Day most commonly falls on the second Sunday in May and traditionally involves presenting mothers with flowers, cards and other gifts.

**May 25th - Memorial Day**

Originally called Decoration Day, from the early tradition of decorating graves with flowers, wreaths and flags. Memorial Day is a day for remembrance of those who have died in service to our country. It was first widely observed on May 30, 1868 to commemorate the sacrifices of Civil War soldiers, by proclamation of Gen. John A Logan of the Grand Army of the Republic, an organization of former Union sailors and soldiers. After World War I, it became an occasion for honoring those who died in all of America's wars and then more widely established as a national holiday throughout the United States.

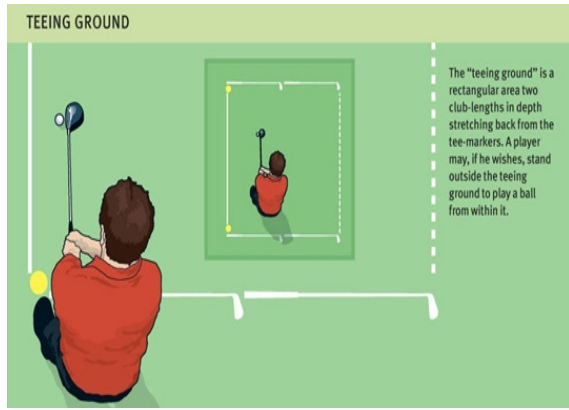

### **CDD Golf Course Update**

The Waterlefe Golf Course has successfully completed the first quarter of 2015 thanks to the professional staff. We currently have 114 Passport Holders and hope to increase these numbers when Janice Reed rejoins Waterlefe as Marketing/Membership Director. We will hold over 150 events for members in 2015 as well as numerous weekly events for resident non-members. Our excellent maintenance staff has kept the course in great condition. The golf course is in the process of contracting with John Deere to provide new maintenance equipment, and the anticipated reduces our monthly costs for this three year contract.

Golf staff working with golf committee and CDD engineer chooses projects based on three criteria: safety, erosion, and playability. Projects are then identified and prioritized for work during non season periods. The staff will be focusing on the completion of the wall on number 15 at the red tee box. Erosion issues will be addressed on holes 8, 10, 11, and 12 this Summer. We are currently inspecting all 9 bridges on the course, and repairs will be done as needed.

Golf course access is limited to playing golf by Passport Holders (members), and paying non-members during operational hours. For safety reasons, residents are asked not to walk, run or exercise their pets on the golf course at any time. At the request of the Bond Holders we had a consultant visit with staff and members of the golf committee and as a result we are already implementing several ideas.

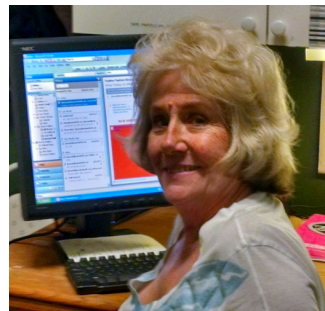

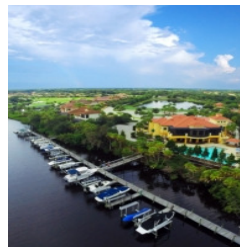
