



## PGA of America Junior Camps

Over the off season, John Andrews (2013 Illinois PGA Teacher of the Year) and Dennis L. Johnsen (General Manager/Head PGA Golf Professional), performed an extensive evaluation of various junior golf camps that Pine Meadow Golf Club has an opportunity to offer.

After a thorough investigation, we have chosen to **replace the Nike golf camps with the PGA of America Junior Camps**. This decision was based on the following:

- The PGA Jr. Camp is more aligned with the ADM (American Developmental Model) for the LTAD (Long Term Athletic Development) of the participants.
- This camp's programming focuses on the development of the youngster not just for golf but for the student's total athletic development related to all sports.
- Instruction is more age specific.
- PGA Camps are designed to have the participant on the golf course more.
- Program is not tied to an individual company brand.
- These camps tie in well with other PGA branded programs such as PGA Jr. League and PGA Family Golf Nights.
- The curriculum is consistent with the concepts of instruction that are consistent with that of our instructors.
- All instructional components of this program have been vetted by the Youth Player Development Committee and staff of the PGA of America.
