Outdoor Court Rebuild Project At Central Park

The History

Our outdoor courts were originally installed in the early 1970s. In 2003 we put down new asphalt on top of the old asphalt. The courts have served us well but have now reached the end of their usable life. We have water seeping up through the asphalt, creating year-round wet spots, cracks and bubbled paint. In addition, we have old and failing concrete around the stadium court, retaining walls and sidewalks.

This project will repair and improve one of the club's largest assets. After fifty years and for the benefit of future families and individuals it is time we bring the outdoor courts back to their pristine condition.

The Project

- Replace the outside asphalt courts with post tension concrete
- Replace walkways, fences, screens, nets, retaining walls and seating on the stadium court
- Improve the landscaping and irrigation
- Add drinking fountains on the courts
- Add cabanas between the courts for shade
- Add power, water and sewer for future restrooms.
- Add conduit for potential, future on-court lighting
