A Course Rating Committee member should have an extensive playing background, and it is desirable that at least one course rating team member have obtained the ability to play at the level of a single digit handicapper at some point in their playing career. For course rating purposes, the state is divided into 4 sections, with teams being responsible for the ratings in a particular region.

A Tournament Committee member should work a minimum of four tournament days during the season. Duties may include course setup, starting, spotting, on course officiating and scoring.

After submitting this form (and confirmation you're an MSGA member), you will be contacted by an MSGA representative to setup an interview. At that time, you will be presented with details about becoming an MSGA volunteer.
