
GOLF CART GUIDELINES

- 1. Observe the 90 degree rule
- 2. Obey the green post and exit the fairway to the cart path
- 3. Keep carts on the cart path around all tees and greens and on all par 3's.
- 4. Handicap flag carts should keep the cart at least 30 feet from the green as much as possible. avoid slopes and limit travel to the shortest route possible.
- 5. Scatter cart traffic when entering and exiting the fairway
- 6. Always buddy up in carts. No single riders unless in a threesome.

With bunker repair work under way, we also ask your attention to the following:

- Enter and Exit all bunkers at the low side only
- Stay off sculpted areas, they will be sodded at the end of the project
- When you rake your foot prints, rake lightly (no need to dig)
- If raking a bunker face, please flip the rake over and level the sand with the smooth side
- If you come to a hole they are working on, play all the bunkers on that hole as ground under repair
- Please watch the golf shop doors for work location updates and continue to keep the safety of everyone in mind

FROM THE SUPERINTENDENTTJ WEST

To say that January was a less than ideal month for golf or turf is an understatement! Cold/wet weather began on New Year's day and lasted throughout most of the month. In January, we recorded 7 frost days and 6.6 inches of rain (with more rain forecasted before the months end)! In January of 2017 we recorded 2 frost days and 2 inches of rain. Frost is to be expected during the winter months in our part of Florida. However, we have seen more temperatures in the high 20's and low 30's that we are accustomed to! Last year we did not see a temperature under 50 until January 8th. This year it seems like on many days, we struggle to get to 50.

February will be an extremely busy month for us at golf maintenance. As you read this newsletter, the renovation of bunkers and removal of trees will already be in progress! Golf Sculptors International has been contracted to perform the work. 900 tons of old sand will be removed in the bunkers and then replaced with USGA Spec. T-Angle sand! T-Angle sand is manufactured to reduce wash outs and aid in drainage. Eroded/weak turf faces and floor leveling will also take place during this time. The project is expected to be completed by April 1st...weather permitting. Shaw Tree Service will be on property for 20 days, beginning on January 29th, to trim/remove trees that were damaged during Irma. They will also remove trees that have been compromised after the storm. Both the bunker crew and tree crew will be under my direct guidance. I ask that you direct all questions or concerns to me and stay a safe distance away from the work in order to let the crews do what they do best!

Even will the weather issues, the course has held up well! Many areas have stayed stronger longer than in past years. The cold weather has turned the turf off colored, but there is a lot of grass out there! We have noticed a significant reduction in Poa Annua from 2017-2018. While we do have areas that are infected with the weed, they have been treated in a more timely manner. In February, we will schedule our first of 4 bulk fertilizer applications and our first of 3 pre-emergent herbicide applications. Greens have remained healthy in spite of the weather. They have a good speed, consistent ball roll, and are full of turf! I cannot ask for much else!

FROM THE HEAD GOLF PROFESSIONAL BILLY VAN ARSDALE

The U.S.G.A. has established a new local rule regarding the accidental movement of the ball and a ball marker when the ball is on the putting surface. This is a local rule that we will put into effect at Grand Haven.

When a player's ball lies on the putting green, there is no penalty if the ball or ball-marker is accidentally moved by the player, his partner, his opponent, or any of their caddies or equipment. The moved ball or ball-marker must be replaced as provided in Rules 18-2, 18-3 and 20-1.

Note: If it is determined that a player's ball on the putting green was moved as a result of wind, water or some other natural cause such as the effects of gravity, the ball must be played as it lies from its new location. A ball-marker moved in such circumstances is replaced.






