GOLF CART GUIDELINES

1. Observe the 90 degree rule
2. Obey the green post and exit the fairway to the cart path
3. Keep carts on the cart path around all tees and greens and on all par 3's.
4. Handicap flag carts should keep the cart at least 30 feet from the green as much as possible. avoid slopes and limit travel to the shortest route possible.
5. Scatter cart traffic when entering and exiting the fairway
6. Always buddy up in carts. No single riders unless in a threesome.

FROM THE SUPERINTENDENT TJ WEST



The month of May started out dry...but ended extremely wet! A little over 11" of rain was recorded during the month, 9" fell over the span of one week, with more forecasted as I write this newsletter. The rain has caused the bunkers to wash multiple times! However, only one has held water for an extended period. Even with all the rain, the course made it through with very few cart restrictions! The golf course's ability to push water through the soil is amazing!

The weather caused us to reschedule the first aerification of greens, tees, fairways, and rough. The new greens aerification dates are Sunday June 3rd and Monday the 4th. The rest of the course will be aerified after those two days. The rain, along with heavy fertilization, has helped the course begin the healing process after a tough Winter. Aerification and a scheduled wall to wall fertilizer application should help finish the process! We were also forced to reschedule our bulk insecticide application for Fire Ants and Mole Crickets. This will be done when the weather permits in June.

May allowed us to complete a few projects that have been on our radar for a long time! You probably have noticed the new yardage sign/landscape bed at the Driving Range, as well as the new tree design tee markers! I would like to thank the Grand Haven Men's Golf Association for donating the yardage sign! It is a good feeling to know that members take pride in the course! We decided to design a simple landscape bed for the sign, in the area where the gazebo was placed. The bear bench in the bed was donated by the Grand Haven Golf Course Maintenance Team. The feedback so far has been great! Our new tee markers were put out on Memorial Day. They are constructed out of 1/4" steel as opposed to the 1/4" aluminum that the previous markers were made of. They are definitely stronger and much easier to get in the ground! We are in the process of taking 36 old markers that are in good shape and painting them red for the short course! This task should be completed soon!

We recently purchased a Reciprocating Edger to eliminate the grass growing in bunkers. Round-up is being applied to the bunker edges and then the new equipment is being used to cut a crisp edge. We have currently completed holes 1-4 in less than a week's time! Our focus in June will be weed control after all the rain, finishing the bunker edging, remove contaminated bunker sand from washouts then replace, and catching up on cultural practices!

Summer Heat is here! Time to make sure you hydrate properly **before** each round or practice session. Every year I write about this, I study a little more on the internet and learn a little more about sports hydration. Any outdoor activity should start with water or a sugar free sports drink about 2 hours before you begin the activity. Most experts agree that during the activity you should try to consume 4-6 ounces every 20 minutes, this is after you have hydrated properly to begin your activity. Every year we have someone who gets close to heat stroke, make sure you are hydrated before your round. This is as important to a good round of golf as warming up your muscles on the driving range before teeing off.

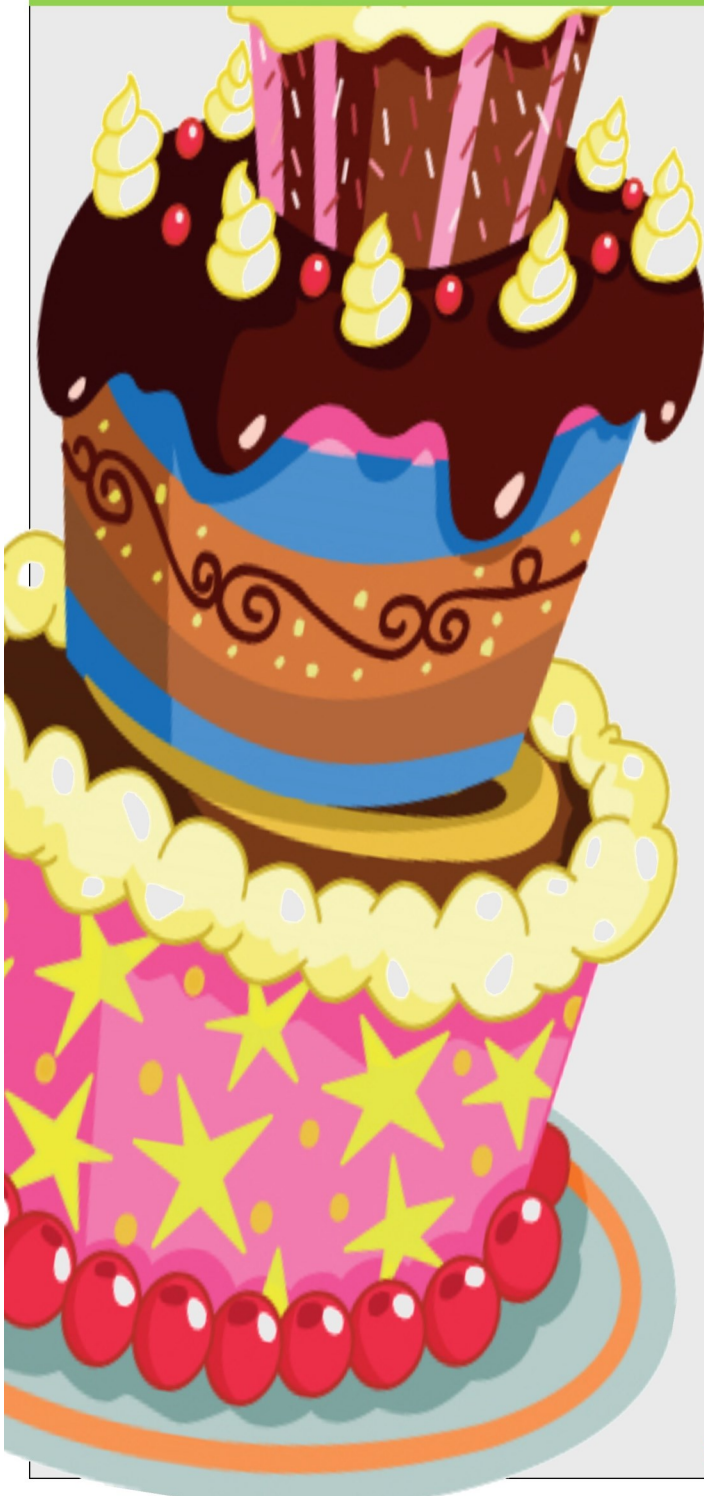

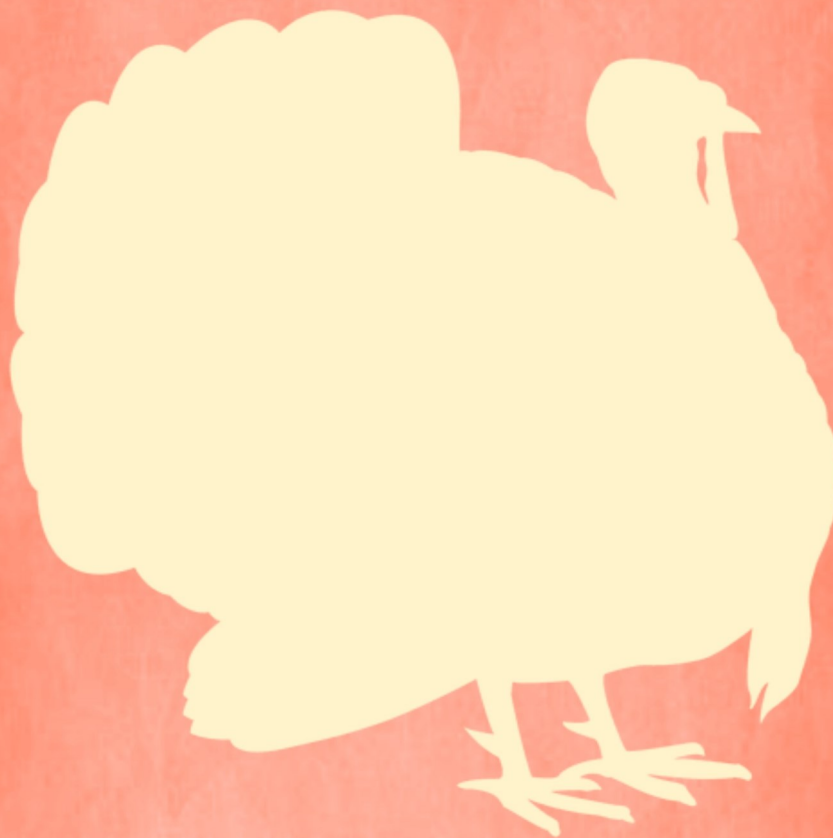
