OVERVIEW:

In developing goals for the Junior Program of Watertown Country Club, one important factor is the educational potential of junior golf. This sport, like many, can provide opportunities for the social, physical, emotional and mental development of each child. Our goal with the WCC Junior Program is to offer multiple positive learning experiences to reinforce this development for your children. Due to the continued popularity of our Junior Program, and our desire to provide an ever improving experience for your children, we will continue to implement a couple of key changes as we did last year. Most notably we will continue to divide the program into 2 different days. This was done primarily with the students in mind. The change will allow us to extend the instruction time for each group, and also help to get more kids out on the golf course faster. Lunch will also be available after golf.

OBJECTIVES:

- 1. First and foremost, be fun! Golf is a game that is meant to be enjoyable.
- 2. Help juniors learn to play the game to the best of their ability. Each child should be taught golf skills, rules, etiquette and basic strategy, and be encouraged to practice and play.
- 3. Contribute to the personal development of each child. Juniors should learn social skills and emotional control as well as other positive character values.

INSTRUCTION:

Instruction for the 6 hole, 3 hole and Pee Wee groups will be on <u>Thursday</u> mornings. The 6 hole group will have instruction at 8 AM and tee off following instruction. The 3 hole group will have instruction at 9 AM and tee off following instruction. The Pee Wee group will have instruction at 10 AM.

The 18 and 9 hole groups will be on <u>Friday mornings</u>. Instruction for the 18 hole group will be at 8 AM and they will tee off following instruction. The 9 hole group will have instruction at 9 AM and will tee off following instruction. RAIN DATE: All groups will have the same rain date if needed on Monday, August 11th.
