## Arizona and Golf

- Spending in 2012 adjusted to 2014 excluding direct spending on airfare, an estimated \$58M in out-of-state visitor direct spending attributed to major golf tournaments
- Annual sales of golf-related business in Arizona was \$270 million



## Water and Golf in Arizona

of Total County Withdrawals for All Uses, 2010

- 130,116 acre-feet of selfsupplied freshwater was used to irrigate golf courses, 1.9% of Arizona's total freshwater withdrawals, excluding effluent use
- Only one county (Santa Cruz) exceeds 5% of total county freshwater withdrawals
- Overall, conservation efforts at golf facilities aim to balance use of natural resources with economic viability of these courses.
