

# 2014 Legend at Arrowhead Men's Club

The Legend at Arrowhead organizes The Men's Club. The Staff does the best they can to provide a fair and entertaining club and promises to listen and consider all input from it's club members.

\*We will hold shotgun starts every Wednesday when participation is above 16 players, unless the event format that week dictates otherwise. We will use tee-times when the player count is 16 and below.

\*The green-fee includes golf, cart, GPS, lunch, prize fund and warm up balls.

\*The prize fund portion will continue to be \$5 and will be paid weekly to winners of the weekly contests. Payout to 30% of the field with prize fund money staying within the flight's during flighted events.

\*We will continue to hold the point participation program to reward consistent play and performance.

\*We would like to continue to reward current members that recruit new members with a \$20 bonus on their credit book.

\*The Pro-Shop staff will manage the weekly events and will be responsible for monitoring of handicaps.

\*ALL PUTT'S MUST BE HOLED OUT! If your ball is on the green it MUST be holed out! Any racking, picking up or swiping to "finish" the hole will result in these penalties:

1 <sup>st</sup> offense:	Verbal warning and disqualification of round
$2^{nd}$ offense:	Loss of 5 points and disqualification
3 <sup>rd</sup> offense:	Suspension of play from Men's Club for 2 events

#### Reminders from 2013

- In events that dictate an 18 hole score, players must finish every hole. Players may not take an "X" or a score indicative of their "Equitable stroke score" for handicap purposes. Players that do not post an actual score will not be counted in weekly standings.

- All credit book must be used before January 31<sup>st</sup>, 2014.

-Pairings **WILL** be decided by a random generator every week unless the week's event dictates otherwise.

A 2014 Summer/Fall Schedule will be posted by the end of May, all event schedules will be posted at The Legend at Arrowhead and online at <u>www.legendatarrowhead.com</u> under leagues. These events are subject to change, but only in certain unforeseen situations.

### **Club Championship**

The Club Championship will be played in a stroke play format and flight's based upon number of entry's and handicaps. The top 30% of the field in each flight will be paid with golf shop credit. Players can win in either gross or net in their flight but can NOT win both. Each player's handicap will remain the same for each day of the Club Championship and will be taken from the handicap report on March 15<sup>th</sup>. Day 1 pairings will be assigned within flights and by handicap index. Day 2 pairings will be assigned using players net score and gross scores for tiebreakers if needed. To compete in the Club Championship a member must have registered for the league by February 4<sup>th</sup>, 2014 and must have played in at least 6 events by the start of the Club Championships first round.

### **President's Cup**

The Presidents Cup will use the most recent handicap issued before the event starts the first week of November and will continue until a champion is crowned. The PC format will be a net match play bracket, the losing players each week will be placed in the following event to coincide with the PC for the remaining weeks. The PC seedings will be paired according to the point standings after the last event before the PC starts. More information about match deadlines and scheduling will be given out during the seeding rounds. To compete in the PC a member must have registered for the league by August 1<sup>st</sup>, 2013 and must have played in at least 12 events by the start of the PC's first round.

Overseed dates are tentatively scheduled for October 6<sup>th</sup>, 2014 through October 17<sup>th</sup>, 2014. We will again host our Men's Club events at another course to be determined closer to our closure. <u>These events will count towards year end points.</u>

DEADLINE: If you do not sign up for the following week, you have until 12:00PM Tuesday to sign-up. If at that time you are not on the sheet and you want to play Wednesday, it is on a stand-by only basis. If there isn't space, you don't necessarily get to play.



Each week, participants will receive (1) point for participation as well as performance. Each week, the following point totals will be given to each golfer according to their success:

1 <sup>st</sup> Place:	:	+ 6 points
2 <sup>nd</sup> Place	:	+ 5 points
3 <sup>rd</sup> Place	:	+ 4 points
4 <sup>th</sup> Place:	:	+ 3 points
5 <sup>th</sup> Place:	:	+ 2 points
6 <sup>th</sup> Place an	d below:	Participation points only

The following point deductions can be levied for repeated offenses. A warning will be given upon the first occurrence of the following.

Slow Play - 2 points (finishing 10 minutes behind the group in front of you) Canceling the day of play: - 1 point No Show without calling - 5 points

Although we understand the Men's Club is based, at least partly on camaraderie and a level of entertainment, the staff and the members of the club need to understand and agree that an acceptable pace must be maintained for the sake of all golfers and the success of the course. Along with pace of play we will be making sure the club follows course rules and guidelines during play. This includes, but is not limited to, leaving the cart path on cart path only days or driving in restricted areas.

The Legend staff reserves the right to deduct points based upon both pace of play as stated above and failure to respect the rules and guidelines of the course. These decisions are at the sole discretion of The Legend staff.

A player must participate in at least 15 events during a year to be eligible to win year-end prizes. The point total prize money is collected from your Men's Club Entry Dues and will be distributed evenly according to the point totals from all players that have participated for a minimum of 15 weeks. The Legend reserves the right to allocate money from that fund for other prizes and awards throughout the year so long as the entire prize fund is used directly for the Men's Club. These allocations are listed but not limited to:

-Special event prize fund/costs -Prize fund for both offsite league events during overseed -End of the year luncheon



ANNUAL FEE: \$110 annually payable to The Legend at Arrowhead

LEAGUE FEES:	Men pay an established league green fee on Wednesday Play Days that will include golf, cart, lunch, \$5 prize fund and warm-up balls.	
PAY OUTS:	25 to 30 percent of the field will be paid in course credit every week. The entire prize fund pool is awarded every week, unless the format and event dictate more than one week; in which case the prize money will be awarded in full at the conclusion of that event.	
HANDICAPPING:	Official GHIN handicaps are issued through the Arizona Golf Association. A minimum of five scores must be posted to receive a handicap that will allow members to win weekly events.	
	These handicaps will be monitored by the club staff and are subject to adjustment for exceptional play above normal expectations set forth by USGA guidelines.	
	Handicaps are good for a calendar year and expire December 31 every year. This is set forth by the Arizona Golf Association. Due to this, pro-ration for late entry is available after June. All members must renew at the beginning of every year regardless of the date they joined.	
EVENTS:	Events are conducted every Wednesday. Start times will be in the morning hours and will change throughout the year according to sunlight and morning temperatures.	
ADDITIONAL BENEFITS:	10% discount on merchandise in the golf shop Special member discounts on green fees for non-league play.
