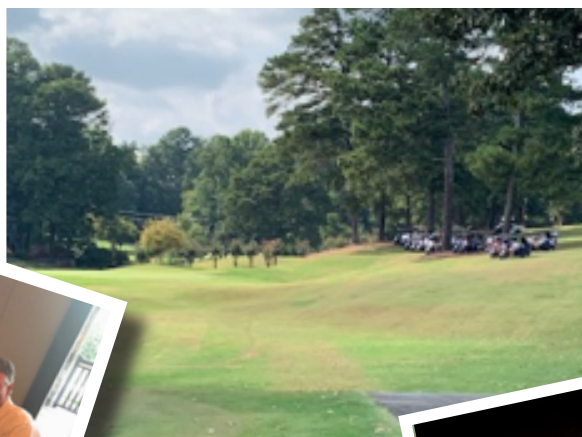

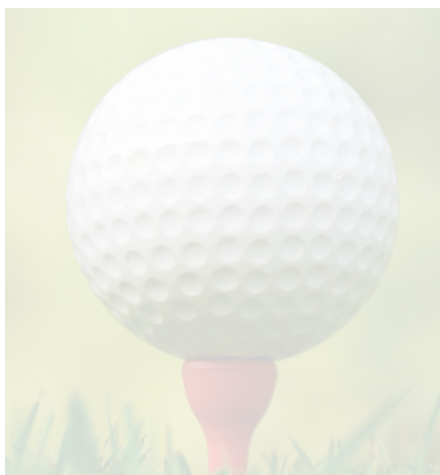

Superintendent News October 2019

Now that we are back in a drought again, I wanted to explain the difference in how the course would look if we had an upgraded irrigation system versus the system we have now. Today, your irrigation system only allows us to water the whole golf course for 9 minutes per irrigation head over a 3-day period. The reason for this is the irrigation main line varies from 2 1/2' class 120 pipe to 6" class 120 pipe. Ninety-five percent of the line is 3' and 4' class 120 pipe. That size limits the amount of water you can push throughout the entire course. Class 120 means the pipe is rated at 120 PSI. To run the irrigation heads the best, you need 125 PSI, 125 PSI running through 120 PSI pipe is the reason you see us repairing a lot of leaks. An upgraded system would have class 200 pipe that ranges from 6" to 12", which means you can push a lot of water through the line and irrigate the entire golf course for 10 minutes per irrigation head in a night and seldom see a leak. So you can see, the upgrade would produce 30 minutes over three nights versus 9 minutes. A great visual to prove our point, during this drought we have been watering #9 and #18 fairways manually each day for 10 minutes per irrigation head. The rest of the course is the 9 minutes every three days cycle. Next time you play, notice how much greener and more playable conditions are on 9 and 18 vs. the rest of the course. Just something to think about in the future.

On Tuesday October 15th after the collegiate tournament has started, we will be closing the driving range to over-seed the tee box and target greens. Once we finish, we will re-open the range to MATS ONLY until the tee is ready to be hit off of. Please do not hit drivers off the grass, your feet wear out large circles on the back of the tee box that will not grow back through the winter.

The North Atlanta Senior Men's Golf Association (NASMGA) has completed the first seven tournaments. Berkeley hosted the September Tournament on Wednesday, September 25. Tournament Chairman Paul Spofford provided the following report: There were 80 signed up to play and all 80 showed up on time...awesome! We had great weather...course in good shape despite the ongoing drought...and some tough pin positions!

Everyone was happy with coffee / bagels / donuts before play and an excellent buffet lunch after play. We played everything "down" and putt out everything unless out of the hole and still finished in 4:15 to 4:30. We paid out the top seven (7) positions plus four closest-to-the-pin awards. We had 15 BHCC players and the BHCC winners were...

1st Place Team...Bill Stanhope was their A player...119 (-25)

3rd Place Team...John Cahill...121 (-23)

4th Place Team...Harvey Gammon was their A player...121 (-23)

5th Place Team...Hugh McGonagle...121 (-23)

6th Place Team...Rick O'Dom was their A player...121 (-23)

Closest to the Pin #1...Bill Stanhope at 5'-6"

A scorecard regression from the #1 handicap hole was used to break the ties.

Our six winners were offset by those of who tried to be good hosts...Ted Wyerman was the A player for the next to last place team at 131 (-13)...and Ray Meyer and I were on the team at 132 (-12) announced as D-A-L.

Berkeley seniors had twice as many participants as any other club - good since we were the hosts. The tournament ran smoothly thanks to Head Pro Shawn McKinnon's assistance with pairings and scoring along with the rest of the pro shop staff...and special thanks to Barry Lakas, Russ Coddington, Steve Kindrick, and John Cahill for their assistance with checking in the players and helping with other details.

NASMGA Match Play:

There are 17 participating Country Clubs in the North Atlanta Senior Men's Golf Association. Sixteen of the clubs have match play teams. The teams were divided into 4 divisions with each team playing the other three from the start of the season with both home and away matches. The top two teams in each division go on to the playoffs. Each match has 12 players from each team playing in 6 flights with two from each team playing a four-ball better ball with two players from the opposition. Each match is worth 3 points, one for the front nine, one for the back nine and one point for the total. Ties are worth 1/2 a point.

Match Play Captain Barry Lakas provided the following report:

Berkeley was in the division that included Brookfield - 61 points; Olde Atlanta/Windemere - 60.5 points; Berkeley - 52.5 points; Crooked Creek - 44.5 points. In the final match against Olde Atlanta/Windemere the score was Crooked Creek- 9.5 and BHCC- 8.5. Not bad for an away match. Notable performances this season- Mike Black taking a whopping 11.5 points; Tom Harvey taking 8 points; Dean Nejame taking 7.5 points; and Paul White taking 7 points. Good playing guys.

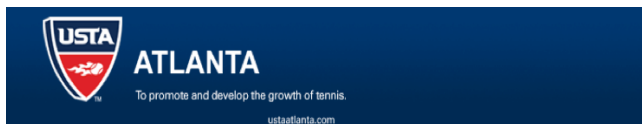

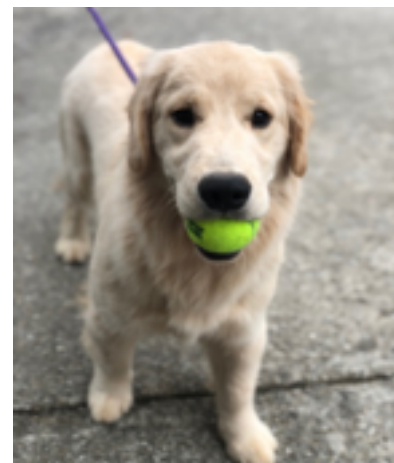
