Men's Club Championship Information

Yes, it is that time of the year again, time for the Men's Club Championship! This year the Club Championship will take place August 16th, 17th, and 18th. We will be taking requests for tee times for Friday's round only. Saturday and Sunday tee times will be taken place in the morning unless the field requires afternoon tee times. All men over the age of 50 who play in one of the Blue Tee Flights will be eligible to win the Gross Senior Club Championship. The Club Championship costs \$80 to play and includes prizes and lunch after golf on Sunday. This is our best event of the year and our most well attended with over 115 players annually teeing it up for glory! Don't forget to sign up in the Golf Shop!

Weekday Senior Club Championship

As in years past we will host the Weekday Senior Club Championship the Wednesday prior to the Men's Club Championship. That date this year will be August 14th, and there will be a modified shotgun start at 9am. The Weekday Senior Club Championship is open to any man 50 years and older. There will be an optional Gold Tee division for those 70 years and older as well. Please stop by the Golf Shop to find out more information and to sign up!

Junior Club Championship

A little known fact, the Junior Club Championship is contested during the Men's Club Championship, a tournament within the tournament. The Junior Club Champion will be determined by the lowest aggregate gross score from any player age 17 years and younger that competes in the Men's Club Championship. Last year's winner, Stephen Kinsel, will not be back to defend his title as he is off to North Georgia College to play on the Men's golf team. To compete in the Club Championship you must have a active GHIN number here at Berkeley Hills, be age 14 years or older with a twelve handicap or less, and play all three tournament rounds from the Blue Tees. Marshall Mode

As you may have noticed our new GPS systems have been largely a success. With the GPS we believe that play overall has quickened and we have received great feedback from members and guests alike. The GPS system also allows us to monitor where each cart can and cannot navigate based upon course conditions, greens, tee boxes, etc. The GPS system can also be changed in to Marshall Mode, allowing the golf cart free access to any area on the golf course. This was not the intention of acquiring the GPS system in the first place. We ask that all members and guest keep the golf carts in its normal mode when using the golf carts. If for whatever reason we find that the golf cart has been changed to Marshall Mode we will fine the individuals using that golf cart an undisclosed amount of money. We do this to ensure that all members and guests are abiding by the necessary rules to help ensure the best possible playing conditions. We thank you for your understanding and cooperation with this matter.

Twilight Rate

Starting April 1, the rate for guests that play after 3pm on weekdays will be only \$45!

New Players Tees

The course has been rated for a new set of tees called the Players Tees. The tees will consist of a combination of Blue and White tees designed to give golfers an option to play the course from a fun but challenging combination of tees. Look for the new Players Tees in the near future on new scorecards. The course has also been rated from the Yellow Junior Tees. This option is intended to be used for beginning ladies and advancing junior golfers for score posting purposes.

Superintendent News August 2019

June is here and so is the hot weather. During the last few weeks of May, we have hit a small drought that has continued until present. The staff and I are watering each night and during the day when we can; our irrigation system is outdated and has a difficult keeping up when there is a lack of rain. The water comes on each night at 8:00 and it takes three days to complete a water cycle for nine minutes. We water the front 9 fairways for 9 minutes the first night, the back 9 fairways for 9 minutes the second night, and tees and green's surrounds for 9 minutes the third night. Greens get watered each night as needed. This is the reason you may see irrigation running during the day.

By the compliments we've been hearing, it seems everyone is in favor of grassing more beds. Ultimately, our goal is to grass all the beds on the course except for the large wooded areas that may need to be used as a deposit for debris. During this summer, I will be pricing our more areas for grass which will include irrigation lines running to those areas. This will allow us to water without having the water hoses lying around.
