What a wonderful month July was for growing grass. The winter-damaged areas of turf on the edges of some greens that needed to heal have finally begun to spread out in response to the warm temperatures mixed with consistent rain. Some areas have completely grown back, and some are on the way. If you look closely, you can see the grass runners spreading a little more every day



While there may still be more patching to do, we are letting the existing turf grow in as much as possible. At the end of the summer, we will then identify any remaining bare areas not likely to grow in before winter dormancy and patch them then if necessary.



Now, you may have noticed a few areas near the greens edges where we expanded them outside the existing cavity during resurfacing last year that have thinned somewhat during the wet weeks of the summer. We are monitoring those areas to determine if the water isn't draining away quickly enough, and we may have to add what's called a "smiley" drain to help those spots stay drier in the future during periods of high rainfall.

In more great July developments, I'm happy to report that the speed of the greens is here and they are running great! I apologize that I was two weeks off my initial estimate on when they'd round into the shape I've been looking for.



If you noticed, we began a light weekly verticut in July to help prevent grain from building in the greens. When we verticut greens we put special reels on the mowers that slice through the grass vertically, thinning out the leaf blade and helping to eliminate grain. Grain refers to the direction the grass wants to grow towards, which can influence the roll of your ball. Really grainy greens tend to produce a slower, bouncier roll, and a lot of cross-

grain is what makes the ball break a different direction against the slope of the green. Now that we have the greens where we want them and we're into August, each week we will slowly raise the height of the greens to get to the winter height by the end of September while maintaining smoothness and speed. When done correctly, you should not see much, if any drop off in the quality of the roll.

As for the rest of the course, I could not be happier with where we're at after a challenging spring and early summer. But that doesn't mean the work will stop. In July we rented a trencher and a concrete saw to lay new drainage off the front right side of #12 green (the old drainage had been damaged by tree root encroachment). That area will be draining much better in the future, and your up-and-downs should get a little easier. We're also keeping an eye on some of the bunker edges that we sodded with Zoysia where the sod has struggled to take hold in the straight-sand base soil. We will keep an eye on those spots, and if they need to be re-patched, we will do it during the fall while the roots are still growing and the slightly cooler conditions are a little better for the Zoysia to take

It's great seeing everyone out enjoying the course. As always, ff you have any questions, please ask.




