### Happy New Year!!!

**W**ell, it's that time of year again, the time for making resolutions. As a grounds maintenance staff our resolution to you, our members, is to keep working to consistently improve the quality and playability of your golf course through our skill and our labor in 2024. We accomplished a lot in 2023, but there is still much more to be done in the year ahead. And even though its cold, winter is the perfect time for us to get a jump start on our new year's resolution, because dormant conditions provide the time to tackle projects on our to-do list that we can't address once green grass returns and we begin firing the mowers up on a daily basis.



Those winter projects will include adding new irrigation sprinkler heads in

areas where we removed trees last fall on #7, #14 and #15. I know you'll enjoy having the chance to play off of turf this next year in spots where we've traditionally been unable to grow grass due to the persistent shade and nutrient absorption large trees and their root systems cause. Our plan is to add in the necessary irrigation for turf growth this winter, then lay down sod in the spring / early summer.

We're also assessing the need for more tree pruning and removal in spots where their presence is making it difficult to provide good turf conditions. There are several trees behind #5 green creating excessive shade and impacting the health of the grass on the green. And left of #15 green a row of Cypress trees is blocking sunlight from reaching that green for the majority of the day. And while we all want to enjoy the beauty and strategic impact of well-positioned trees around the course, we also want to make sure those trees aren't creating a roadblock to providing consistently great putting surfaces for you on every hole.

Talking about our 2024 plans, I would like to take a moment to remind everyone that our success this year on the golf course will be a family effort, from both the grounds staff and the membership. We both must be working towards the same common goal. On the employee side, we pledge to devote our effort and expertise to following the maintenance practices that will pro-

duce the best possible playing conditions. And as members, you have the responsibility to both treat the course properly when you play, leaving it in better shape for both you and your fellow members, and also the responsibility to, as a membership, provide the resources necessary for your grounds staff to take care of our part of the job. Never forget that Berkeley Hills is your golf course, and every member must share a commitment to making it better every day.

I can't tell you how excited I am to see what we accomplish this year. So far, Mother Nature has treated us pretty well this winter through December. Let's all pray she treats us great through the spring and into the summer, and provides us the best possible growing conditions for success in 2024.

Hopefully you had a wonderful Christmas, and also enjoy a happy and healthy New Year. I'll see you around the course, and as always, if you have any questions, please ask anytime.

# GOLF NEWS

Every New Year serves as a time to both look ahead to the future, and also to reflect on the experiences and lessons learned from the justconcluded year that was. In 2023 Berkeley Hills certainly went through a few changes and growing pains. We gained some great new additions to the Berkeley family, and also lost some special long-time members along the way that will remain in our hearts and memories moving forward.

As we take our first steps into 2024, I look forward to the memories we'll make and the great times we'll have together this year. And we've been hard at work preparing for Berkeley's 60th anniversary year. Many of our major golf tournaments are already scheduled, and we are finalizing the rest of the golf calendar this month, including our Senior Men's and WGA events. You won't lack for opportunities to enjoy fun and friendly competition at Berkeley in the days ahead.

Now, New Year's always brings resolutions and changes, and an exciting change for 2024 will be a new course scorecard for players to utilize. These redesigned cards will feature all our current tees, including the Senior Players tee. We will be getting a limited number of the new cards in shortly to get us through to April, when the course is scheduled to be re-rated. Once that updated rating is finalized, our permanent cards will be printed. And at the same time we'll also be getting a newly designed Member bag tag later this month (more details to follow asap).

Regarding other exciting changes, we will start experimenting a little later this year with a single tee start on the weekends, instead of the double-tee start off #1 & #10 simultaneously. Most of our member's current weekend times will be kept in a similar time frame with some small adjustments, and the change to a single tee will provide for a more continuous flow of traffic on the course and in the clubhouse throughout the day. When instituted there will be no more blackout times between 9:45 and 12:30, permitting members to schedule times later in the morning when desired. And perhaps most importantly, this change will give the grounds crew more time to accomplish the daily setups tasks necessary to maintain the course in consistently great condition.

Finally, as we are once again in the wet winter months, please be careful when you're around chronic wet areas on the course. As mentioned last month, hole #5 & #6 are each cart path only again this winter. I'd ask you to obey that policy and please do not turn GPS monitors off on the carts to drive off the path on those holes, as doing so will result in "non-refundable" billing questions. Also, keep pull carts off tees, collars, and greens. At no time should pull carts be driven across any tee box or in the wet areas around greens. And although the grass is in dormancy, please continue to sand divots and repair ball marks. Remember, our actions this winter play a huge role in impacting how good conditions will be for us this spring and summer!

### BY-LAWS AMENDMENT PROPOSAL

The Berkeley Hills Board of Governors is committed to promoting the growth of the Berkeley Hills membership roster. Growing the club's membership base provides a corresponding increase in both dues revenue and additional revenues generated from new member expenditures for goods and services purchased at BHCC. That additional income is then allocated towards improving the amenities the club offers to both enhance the current member experience and also to increase Berkeley Hills' competitive advantage in the north Atlanta marketplace.

In order to further the goal of growing the membership roster, the Board of Governors has identified the need for Berkeley Hills to offer a true social membership that will provide dining, clubhouse and pool access to members at a reduced monthly dues price relative to the club's current social membership. The existing social membership includes the privileges mentioned above, as well as tennis and pickleball privileges, and as such is priced as a more expensive racquet sports membership.

The Board is confident that by offering a true social membership that is more competitively priced, Berkeley Hills will be able to attract more new members from the local community and by doing so both increase the dues line and create more member usage and spend at our restaurant, clubhouse and pool facilities.

At this year's Annual Meeting, current members will have the opportunity to vote on the candidates running for the Board of Governors, and will also consider approving the proposed amendments required in the by-laws to add the desired social membership class. All voting members are encouraged to vote this year and by doing so participate in shaping Berkeley Hills' path for future success and growth.
