### Marshall Mode

As you may have noticed our new GPS systems have been largely a success. With the GPS we believe that play overall has quickened and we have received great feedback from members and guest alike. The GPS system also allows us to monitor where each cart can and cannot navigate based upon course conditions, greens, tee boxes, etc. The GPS system can also be changed in to Marshall Mode, allowing the golf cart free access to any area on the golf course. This was not the intention of acquiring the GPS system in the first place. We ask that all members and guest keep the golf carts in its normal mode when using the golf carts. If for whatever reason we find that the golf cart has been changed to Marshall Mode we will fine the individuals using that golf cart a undisclosed amount of money. We do this to ensure that all members and guests are abiding by the necessary rules to help ensure the best possible playing conditions. We thank you for your understanding and cooperation with this matter.

Starting April 1, the rate for guests that play after 3pm on weekdays will be only \$45!

### New Players Tees

The course has been rated for a new set of tees called the Players Tees. The tees will consist of a combination of Blue and White tees designed to give golfers an option to play the course from a fun but challenging combination of tees. This option is intended to be used for beginning ladies and advancing junior golfers for score posting purposes.

## Summer Rules Reminders

As the golfing season gets underway, what better time to remind our members of a few Club rules.

- Pace of play at Berkeley Hills is 4 hours or less.
- Walkers may hop on a cart only from 14 green to 15 tee. Any other time walkers will be charged a “hop on” fee.
- Children are able to use the clubs as members until the age of 24 or at the time they graduate college, whichever is first. After that time they are considered guests and may only use the Club as your accompanied guest.
- The dress code for the course and practice facility requires shirts to be tucked in and caps to be on forward.
- Pull carts and electric pull carts are not allowed across any putting greens.
- At no time should your bag be placed on the green.
- All scores are required to be posted. The Handicap Committee will be reviewing score posting this spring and will adjust handicaps as necessary.

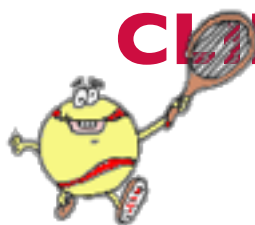
