Superintendent News July 2022

Wow!!! June was one hot month. The two weeks, after the day we planted the greens, were brutal trying to get the grass to take root. You may have seen us planting more grass on Hole 10 and 13; when Pike Creek came to inspect how the greens looked, they felt like they needed to add more grass to those greens to catch them up with the others. Now, the greens are doing fine, and #10 and #13 are catching up. We have mowed all the greens 4 times, and we are beginning to lower the heights. Soon, we will begin to topdress the greens with sand quite frequently until the day comes that we open. When the greens get near playable, we will begin our foliar fertility program, fungicide program, and plant growth regulator program. I'm hoping, not guaranteeing, the sometime at the end of July or the beginning of August, that I will be notifying Shawn along with the Board to see if the greens meet the expectations of opening.

The golf course is doing fine. The hot, dry drought in June was very difficult to manage. We were using 90% of the water for the greens. Some of the irrigation lines that had almost grown in, began to burn back out from the lack of water. Hopefully July will be a better month for us for growing grass everywhere.

Opportunities to play other courses during the conversion:

The Berkeley Pro Shop has enlisted the help of other courses to provide reciprocal arrangements for golf. Other fine clubs including TPC Sugarloaf, St. Ives, Echelon and the Atlanta Country Club are accepting Berkeley members and making tee times available.
