As you have noticed we have had no rain. Last month we had planned on seeding new fescue areas before the leaves fall, and due to not having any rain, we have had to suspend these projects until next Spring. We have re-seeded the normal fescue areas. Once we can get some establishment with these areas, we will re-seed left of #16. This is the time when the leaves will begin to fall. Since the Fall has been warm, it has delayed the leaves coming down. Over this month, we will do a lot of clean up. There will be times we finish with a hole and 30 minutes later it will be covered again. The days the wind blows very hard, it brings down a lot of pinestraw from the trees. We will clean those holes separately because we can use that pinestraw in our beds. You will notice at times a large pile of pinestraw laying in a bed to be spread. Let's pray for the rain. We need the Bermuda grass to go dormant this winter in its healthiest form.
