Description of Player Club Program 18 hole & 9 hole PC

--Must email jrjgc@premiergc.com (or phone to host course) listing the junior's name, clinic and play division (18 or 9 holes) no later than Sunday by 3PM the week of the event to sign up. **NO LATE SIGNUPS WILL BE ACCEPTED.**--Juniors will play 18 hole or 9 hole competitions throughout the season. All **Players Club members** have the option of purchasing a 90 day pass for \$125. This pass is good any day of the week with the exception of playing after 12pm on weekends and holidays.--Juniors will pay \$10 per event (non pass holders). If the Juniors have a 90 day pass they don't have to pay a fee to play in the events. 9 hole PC juniors will pay \$8 per event for 9 holes.--All Major events (notated by a * on the schedule) are events that **must be paid in advance**. These events will cost \$15 with a 90 day pass and \$35 without the 90 day pass. Juniors can get a sign up form at either golf course for these events.--All Juniors in this club will need to post scores on the posting computers in clubhouses or on GHIN.com (Golf Handicap and Information Network). If the junior is not aware of this process, please have them check with one of the pro staff and they will be able to assist.--**All Juniors who place in an event will receive prizes from the golf shop and or medals**.--We will send out the pairings on Monday afternoons by email. All juniors & parents are responsible to look for that email or to call the pro shop after 5:00 for the tee times of the player. We cannot guarantee a junior will play with one of their friends. We will try, but no guarantees.--All Juniors must arrive on site at the host course at least 20 minutes prior to their tee time.--Juniors will be moved from a forward tee flight, to a further back tee flight, depending on their competitive skill level. This will be decided by the Pro staff.--We often will award prizes for places in each flight. This will depend on the number of kids playing in each flight. As a general rule of thumb, we "pay out" the top 25% of the flight.--All PC Juniors should attend the clinic which starts at 10PM with the first tee time of most events at 12:00PM. --When we feel a Junior from the 9 hole division has a good understanding of the rules, golf etiquette, can keep up with pace, is strong enough to play 18 holes and hits the ball well enough to compete, we will move them to the 18 hole Players Club.

Description of Players in Training Program

-- Must email jrjgc@premiergc.com (or phone to host course) listing the junior's name and clinic they will attend no later than Sunday by 3PM the week of the event to sign up. **NO LATE SIGNUPS WILL BE ACCEPTED.**--Bring own clubs if you have them or contact us if the junior does not have clubs, so we can be prepared to provide them. -Show up at least 10 minutes early.--Most events will play on practice holes @ Legion and have clinics only at Walter Hall.--Juniors will sign up by time slot according to age (for the most part this is on a first come, first serve basis). We will do the best we can to get back to you by email on Tuesday afternoon exactly what time the Junior will be doing his/her clinic. All juniors and parents are responsible to look for that email or call the pro shop on Tuesday evening to verify the clinic they are in. If a junior wants to do a clinic with another junior that is not in the same age bracket/time slot we will do our best to accommodate. Please note this information on the email when you send it.--9AM ages 8-14--10:30AM ages 12-18. Our goal is to get these juniors into the Players Club/9 hole PC as fast as possible. We move them up when we feel they are ready to get onto the golf course.--**FAMILY GOLF NIGHT for the PIT students and family members is a lot of fun**. We would like to see each junior come out for a night on the course with an adult (parent or friend) and play 4 holes on our normal 18 hole golf course. Cost for the 4 holes will be \$5 per person. Please see schedules for dates and times. Once the \$40 membership is paid, there is no additional cost for the clinics.

JOE RICHER JUNIOR GOLF CLUB *CODE OF CONDUCT and RULES*

The Joe Richer Junior Golf Club provides a worthwhile activity which can be pursued throughout life and helps develop character and good sportsmanship. All JRJGC competitions are conducted under the USGA Rules of Golf, as amended by the local rules. In addition, the following is a Code of Conduct, which is a guideline for junior golfers to follow throughout the tournaments, both on and off the course. It is not intended to intimidate players, but to help JRJGC members understand the consequences of their actions.

1. **USE DECENT AND PROPER LANGUAGE AND BEHAVIOR AT ALL TIMES.**
 - a. UNSPORTSMANLIKE CONDUCT EXAMPLES
Cheating, unreported violation of a USGA Rule of Golf, swearing, obscene vulgar language or gestures, throwing clubs, displaying poor attitude, behavior or conduct.
 - b. PROHIBITED USE
Smoking, or use of tobacco or chewing tobacco, alcohol or drugs (unless with medical authorization).
2. **RESPECT AND CARE FOR THE PROPERTY OF OTHERS AND THE GOLF COURSE**
 - a. PROPER EXAMPLES
Replace divots, repair ball marks, rake bunkers and use proper containers for garbage.
 - c. IMPROPER EXAMPLES
Damaging greens, defacing or destroying club property, littering, leaving divots or ball marks, failure to rake bunkers, etc.
3. **GOLF ATTIRE FOR BOYS AND GIRLS**
 - a. PROPER ATTIRE
Neat and clean clothing, shoes, mid-thigh length golf style shorts, skirts or long pants. All caps must be worn bills forward, and shirts must be tucked in.
 - b. IMPROPER ATTIRE
Tennis or short shorts, tank tops, cut-offs, sweats, spandex and halter-tops.
4. **ELECTRONIC DEVICES ARE PROHIBITED FOR USE ON COURSE.**
 - a. PROHIBITED DEVICES INCLUDE: cellular phones, noise making pagers, radios, walkman and or any other similar noise-making device.

PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION OF CODE OF CONDUCT:

First Infraction:	Warning
Second Infraction:	Disqualification but can play in next event
Third Infraction:	Disqualification from this and next event
Fourth Infraction:	Disqualification and cannot play rest of year
Note:	Disqualification can preempt warning if violation is flagrant.

RULES

1. Motorized carts are not permitted. Pull carts are allowed. Caddies would need to check and be cleared for approval by the host Golf Professional after a briefing of caddy responsibilities. Caddies would then need to introduce themselves to the Starter for final clearance. A caddie must be at least 15 years of age and not a parent or grandparent.
2. Picking-up (quitting) without permission before play has ended will result in disqualification and suspension from the next event.
3. Players must register for the current week event by 3PM on Sunday or there is ***no guaranteed entry*** into the event. Withdrawals may be made at least 24 hours prior to an event with notice to pro shop.
4. No-shows with less than 24 hours notice will result in suspension from next event.
5. Players may be penalized for slow play if more than one hole is open ahead or if not completing a set of holes in a time specified by the Rules Committee. A player may be subject to penalty if observed to require in excess of 40 seconds each for two separate shots. To keep play moving, no practice shots, including practice putting is allowed at any time while on the golf course.
6. Galleries (including parents) must keep a distance of 25 yards from the players and should walk in rough*. No coaching or advice is allowed. The first infraction will result in a warning to the spectator. The spectator will be asked to leave the course if there is a second infraction. If the spectator refuses to leave, the player may be disqualified. The player is responsible for the actions of family, relatives or friends in the gallery.
7. After players have left the attesting table, cards are officially turned into the Committee and no changes may be made.
* Volunteer Parents are the only non staff adults allowed to walk with the players.

How to sign up for a PIT Clinic or Players Club event and why

You can email the golf shop beginning Thursday before the weeks event, the last day to take signups will be 3PM Sunday before the event.--This needs to be done so we can staff the instructors accordingly and make the pairings.--To sign up you can email jrjgc@premiergc.com .--To sign up via phone (if you don't have email) call the host course, Legion 425-259-4653 ext 0 or Walter 425-353-4653 ext 0.--When you email or call, we'll need the juniors name, age, Clinic and the tee box color he/she normally plays (if Player Club)...EMAIL IS BEST...PLEASE USE EMAIL.

All Joe Richer Juniors must abide by the USGA rules of golf and the Joe Richer code of conduct. Any Junior not abiding by the rules may be suspended or removed from the Junior club without question.
