### *League Play Policy 2016*

The following policies are intended to make all leagues run smoothly and to make sure that our mutual expectations are clear. If you have any questions regarding this league policy, please contact the Golf League Coordinator. We reserve the right to exercise our discretion for items that may not be mentioned below.

- To schedule a league or traveling league, please contact the Golf Event Coordinator. He/She can tell you which dates are available and can mail a league packet to your group.
- You may schedule your league to tee off at a mutually agreed upon time on the weekdays.
- Your league must sign up for a minimum of 4 tee times (16 players) per play date.
- Leagues are required to schedule a minimum of 12 consecutive weeks on the same day of the schedule among the week; traveling leagues may schedule among the four facilities (Interbay, Jackson Park, Jefferson Park, or West Seattle) for a minimum of 12 weeks and must be played on the same day of the week.
- Leagues are required to pay \$40.00 per player (Merchandise Credit) per season, based on your peak number of players. The entire \$40.00 will be distributed in the form of credit book accounts established at your league course for each person who earns prize money. Please forward to us a list of your players who are to receive prize money so that we can set up 'credit book' accounts to be used for merchandise only.
- Upon approval of the play dates, a contract will be mailed to your league coordinator. The signed contract must be returned within 30 days of the mail date and must be accompanied by a **10%** deposit. The deposit will be credited toward fees due.
- The balance of your fees is due 14 days before your first league play date. At that time, a credit book account will be established in your league's name and your prize funds will be made available to you for any advance purchases.
- We ask that all of your league players be aware of, and respect our course rules and pace of play guidelines. Your league coordinator will be responsible for making sure that these rules and guidelines are followed for the enjoyment of all.
- In an effort to maximize the use of the golf course with full groups (4 some) as much as possible, any unused tee times, or openings with your league groups, on your day of play will potentially be filled with stand bys if any exist, at the discretion of the golf course.
- Puget Sound weather is unpredictable and all golfers should be prepared for adverse weather conditions. Please read and be familiar with the Premier Golf Weather Policy.
- We aerify and topdress our greens two times per year: one time each in the spring, and fall. Contact the Golf Event Coordinator or visit our course information board for tentative target dates.
- In accordance with Washington state law, the entire golf course is a licensed premise. It is unlawful to bring your own alcohol to the facility. We also do not allow ice chests on the course.
- Please purchase all of your food and beverage through the golf course restaurant. All arrangements for food and beverage service can be made through the restaurateur once your event has been confirmed.
