2019 Seattle Amateur Championship <u>Conditions of Competition</u>

Conditions of the Competition:

The Championship is a 54-hole stroke play event, with a 36-hole cut to the low 54 and ties. The USGA Rules of Golf shall govern all play. All decisions made by the Tournament Committee concerning the competition are final. In addition, the following rules are in effect:

- > Summer Rules are in effect.
- ➢ Blue Tee markers are in use for the tournament. Yardage on the scorecard is measured from the Blue Tee Monuments. (Black at West Seattle GC)
- In the event of a tie for the Championship, the winner will be determined in a 2-Hole aggregate playoff on holes #17 & #18. If at the end of the two holes we still do not have a champion then it will move to sudden death starting on hole #18, then #17, repeating this sequence until a champion emerges.
- > The "One Ball Rule" is NOT in effect.
- ➤ DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICES we WILL BE using the local rule that allows players to use GPS, Laser or any other artificial form of distance ONLY measuring device.
- PROHIBITION OF ELECTRONIC DEVICES To avoid distractions, the use of cellular phones, electronic tablets, noise-making pagers, iPods and other similar electronic devices for communications purposes or music listening will be prohibited during championship play. Multifunctional devices may be used as a Distance Measuring Device or as otherwise provided under the Rules.
- Golf Carts for use by competitors, caddies and spectators is allowed for this year's event but please be cognizant of the players around you at all times.
- > Starting Times for Wednesday July 4th will range from 7:00am 9:30am and will be available at http://premiergc.com/-seattle-amateur and through the daily tournament email blast.
- Suspension of play When play is suspended for a dangerous situation, competitors shall discontinue play immediately and shall not thereafter resume until the Committee has ordered resumption of play. PENALTY FOR BREACH: Disqualification. Note: Suspension for a dangerous situation is signaled by a long continuous blast. Resumption is signaled by two consecutive blasts.
- Dress Code All players and CADDIES shall wear appropriate golf attire during tournament rounds. Slacks, golf shorts and golf shirts with collars are appropriate. No cutoffs, basketball shorts, T-shirts or colored denim are allowed. Shoes must be worn. Failure to adhere to this dress code will result in DISQUALIFICATION.
- The Prize Fund for this year's event is \$6030 and will be divided among the top-30 players.
