Seattle Parks, Premier Golf and the staff at the tournament courses are pleased to be hosting this prestigious event as it brings out the top amateur players in the Northwest. Our field of 140 players is especially strong this year with more than 50 who have GHIN indexes less than zero including 42 players who currently play for their collegiate teams.

We also look forward to welcoming back six past-champions including our defending champion and current Washington Open Champion Drew McCullough. The field will be cut after 36 holes of play to the low 54 players and ties who will earn the right to compete for the title of Seattle Amateur Champion. The pairings for the final day will be announced after play on Saturday and will be determined by total score for the first two days. Tee times for the final round will range from 7:00 am to 9:30 am.

A few things that should be noted:

- Competitors will be starting on both #1 and #10 tees for the first two days. Leave yourself a few extra minutes to get to the proper tee.
- Please take a moment to read the conditions of the competition. Many questions regarding tournament policy are answered there.
- Carefully double-check your starting time and tee assignment for each of the first two days. You may also confirm them at <http://premiergc.com/-seattle-amateur>
- The top 5 finishers will earn 2017 Hudson Cup points. Call the PPGA office for more details.
