A public golf course approximately 5,300 yards long from the furthest back of its three sets of tees, Thunderbolt Pass had nearly 30,000 rounds of play in 2015.

"I am excited that Green Golf Partners has extended this opportunity to me to serve as general manager and head golf professional at Thunderbolt Pass," said Montgomery. "I've been playing golf here since I was 8 years old and have been a member of the staff since 2011."

Thunderbolt Pass has a variety of leagues throughout the week, including men's, women's and junior competitions. Its clubhouse, which opened with the course in 1974, includes a bar and snack area. A driving range is situated next to the course.
