Roberts Golf Course it hired Goldie Bateson as the first female head golf professional in Wisconsin in 1955, where she remained for 21 years. In 1978 the club and course were purchased by the city of New Berlin and renamed the New Berlin Hills Golf Course. The Root River runs through seven of the course's 18 holes, which play on a layout that ranges from 5,346 yards to 6,517 over four sets of tee boxes.

Piratzky served as an operations assistant for the 2012 Ryder Cup at Medinah, Illinois as well as a tournament operations associate for the International Junior Golf Tour and a volunteer at the 2006 and 2007 Tournament Players Championship. As director of programming for the Chicago Park District he added value to the Chicago Park District Golf portfolio through continual design, establishment and implementation of innovative and successful golf programs.

Piratzky, who resides in Wauwatosa, WI, earned a Bachelor of Arts degree in Sports Management from Flagler College in St. Augustine.
