The Caloosa Club, the newly renovated bar/restaurant, provided dinner following the scramble. "The menu of Rum Glazed Ribs, Chicken Char Siu, and Kalua Pork was a HUGE hit! Everyone loved having the variety of foods compared to the traditional hot dogs and hamburgers," Thomas said.

"This renewal has generated a level of excitement among golfers and non-golfers at Cape Royal. Green Golf Partners can be proud of what has been accomplished since the lease signing earlier in 2017. We are very happy with our relationship, and look forward to a great 2018," Cooper said.

World Long Drive Champion Bobby Bradley of Wellington, Florida, hosted a long drive contest that alone generated about \$1,700 for the Cape Royal Community Foundation, part of nearly \$5,000 raised during the event.
