



Warmer Weather Brings Bonus Rounds for Upper Midwest Golf Courses in November

Green Golf Partners Sees Significant Uptick in November with Above Normal Air Temperatures Before the Holiday Season Begins

CHICAGO and INDIANAPOLIS – November 6, 2015 – Indianapolis-based Green Golf Partners (GGP), which manages 15 golf courses in Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Wisconsin and the Southeast, has seen continued significant growth in rounds played with unseasonably warm weather in the upper Midwest. Since November 1, the National Weather Service has reported temperatures as high as the upper 70's to low 60's during the day, which is an unusual blessing for dedicated amateur and professional golfers alike.

"These blue skies and warmer temperatures have created additional "bonus" revenue directly to our golf properties bottom line," said Matt McIntee, CEO of Green Golf Partners. "Our general managers at courses from Des Moines to Indianapolis and Chicago are working overtime to meet the unprecedented demand for serious and casual golfers to come out to play before snow blankets courses in a few short weeks."

"We are seeing so many new faces coming out to play golf at Jester Park this past week," said Roy Michael, General Manager for Jester Park Golf Club in Granger, Iowa. "We did over 180 rounds on Tuesday and 135 rounds on Wednesday, which most courses in the area do not reach in their prime time season during the summer."
