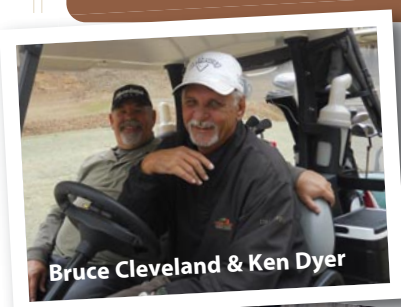

## Maintenance Update

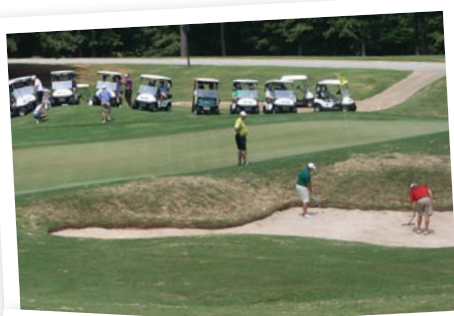
Spring-Time in our local region could arguably begin as early as mid-February solely based on the Noon-Day sun's angular height over the horizon. However, regardless of my interpretation concerning spring's arrival, weed control is definitely a hot topic at this time of year. Frequently I am asked a variety of weed related questions so, I will give you my basic "Two Step" approach to having mostly weed-free turf. First, at some point mid-February through early March apply a liquid pre and post emergent herbicide solution. Then follow up with a granular pre-emergent and fertilizer combination product sometime mid-March through early April. It's that simple! Start now and always follow label directions.

Outside of weed control on the course, some of this year's projects will include adding sand to a number of bunkers lacking adequate depth as well as repairing deteriorated concrete slabs of cart path. Also, most recently approved, a past and present memorial located in the turf area adjacent to
