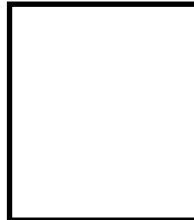

- **The age range for the Junior Golf Program will be 8-17 years old.**

The number of holes played for this group will range from 3 - 6 holes and will be determined by skill level at the discretion of the Golf Staff.**
- **The Advanced Players (9 & 18 holers) will be offered (2) 30 minute private lessons to be taken at any point throughout the summer and must be scheduled through the Golf Staff. These private lessons are included in the junior golf fee.**
- **July 16<sup>th</sup> & 17<sup>th</sup> – Junior Club Championship**
- **The Junior Golf fee for 2014 will be \$75.**
