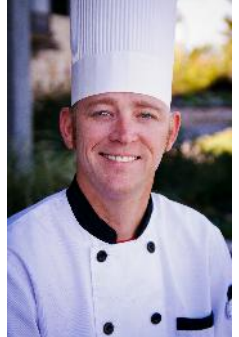

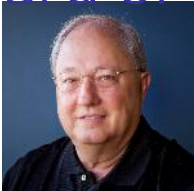

We expect an early sell out so RSVP today! Guests are Welcome.

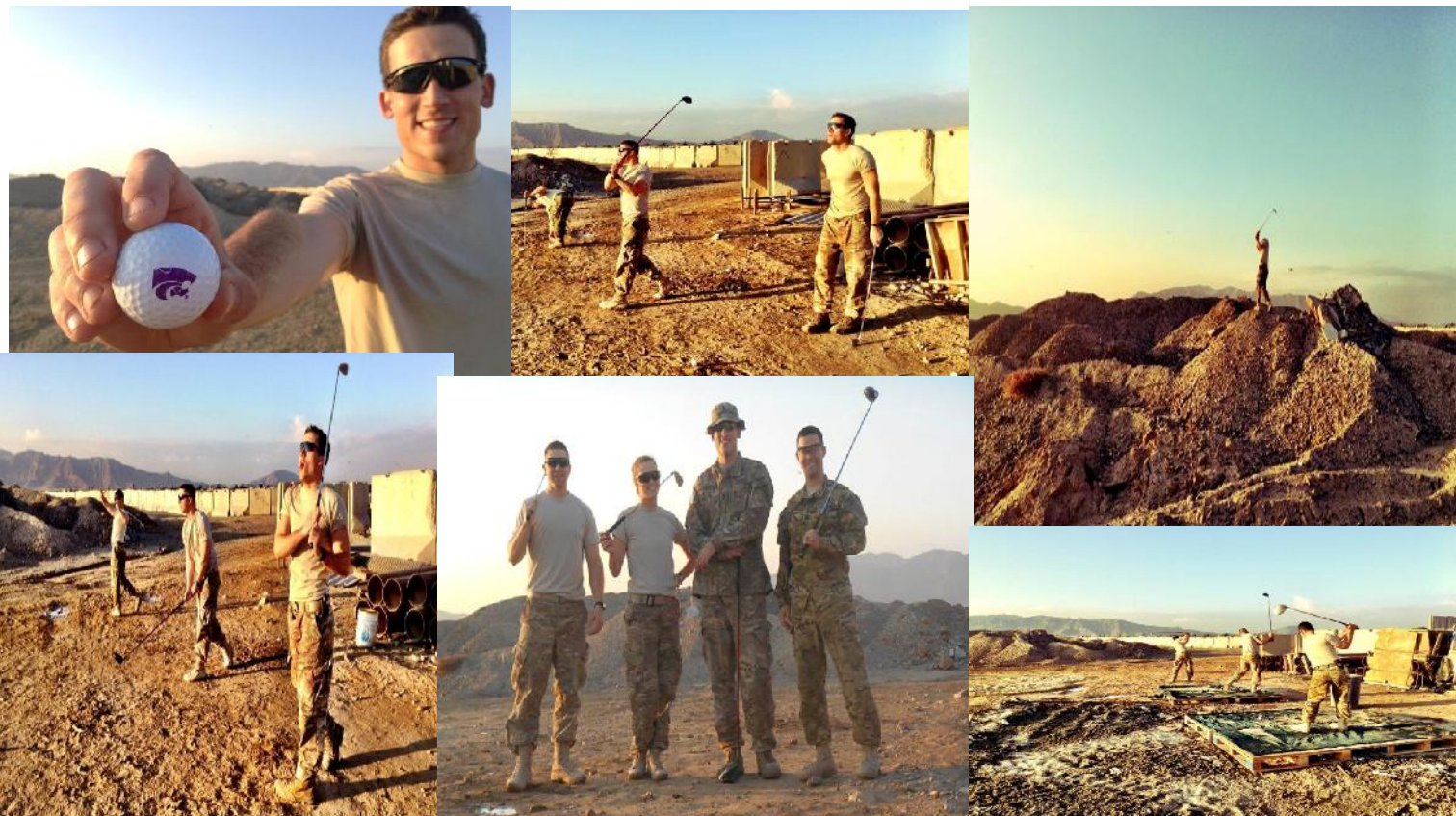


Member Information

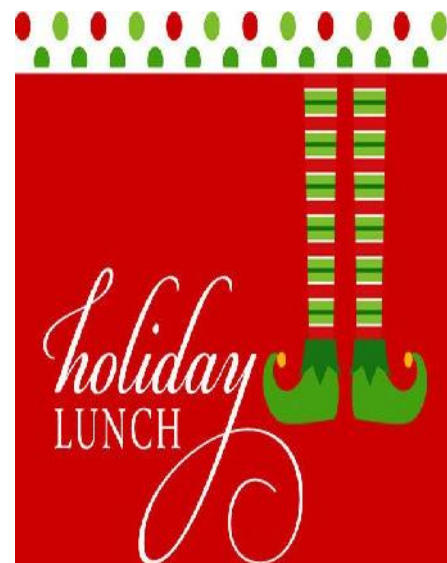
