Wow, time is flying by. The pool has been opened for over a week now. We hope to see you relaxing poolside all summer!

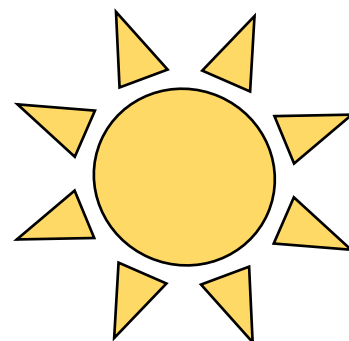

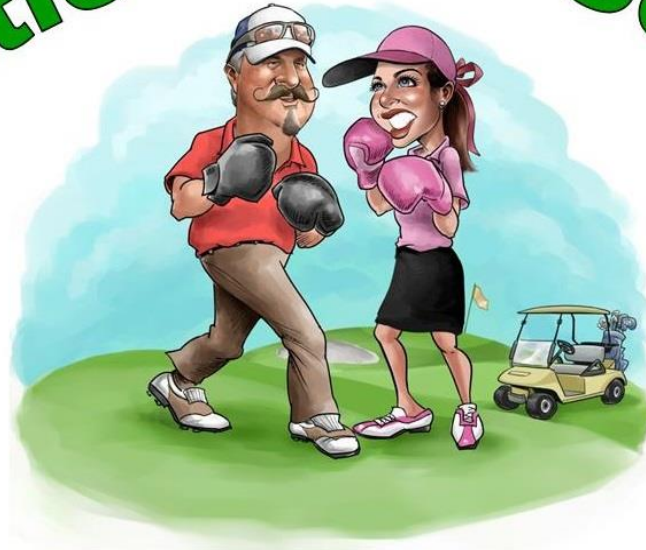

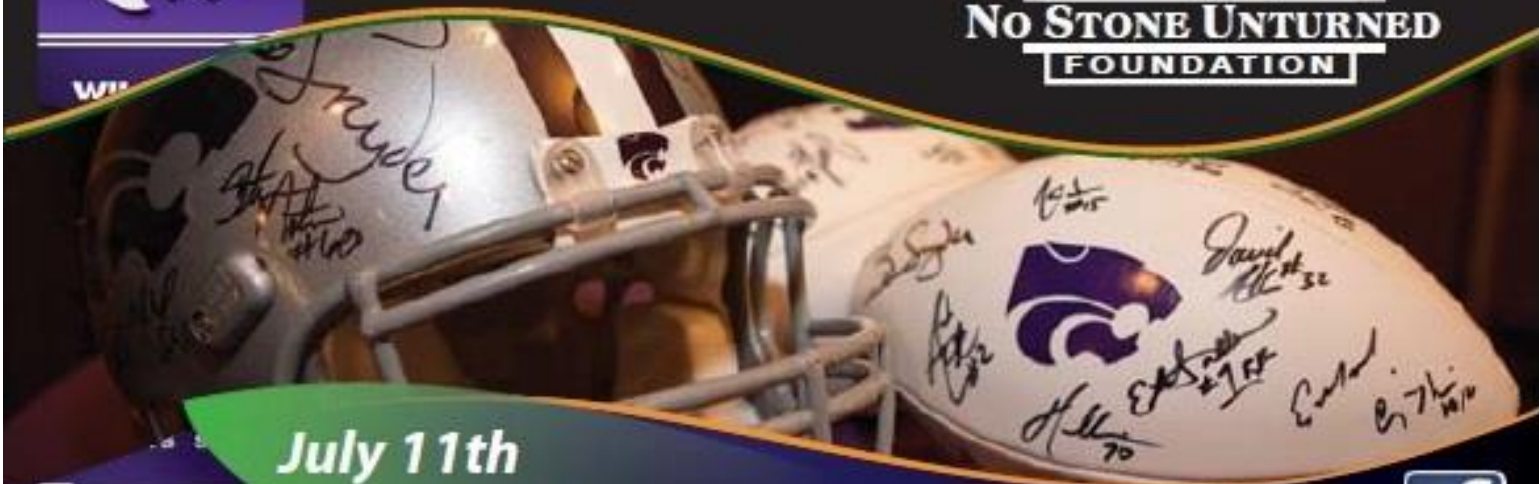
