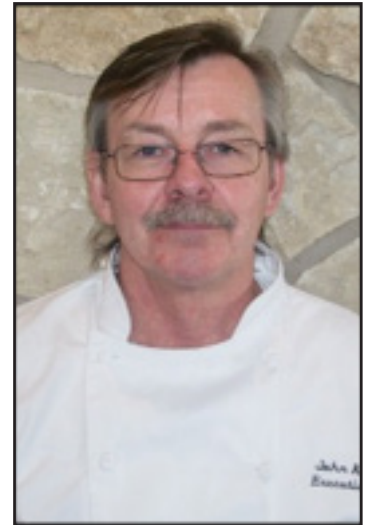

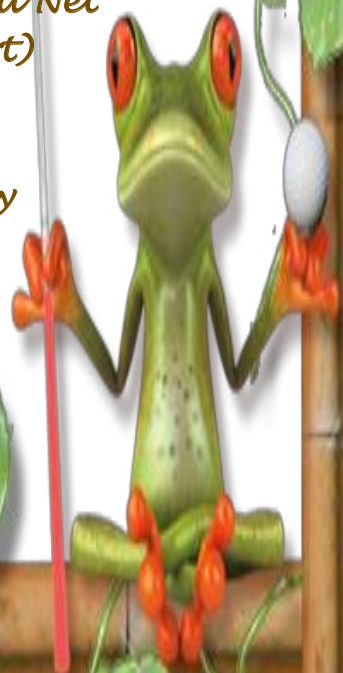

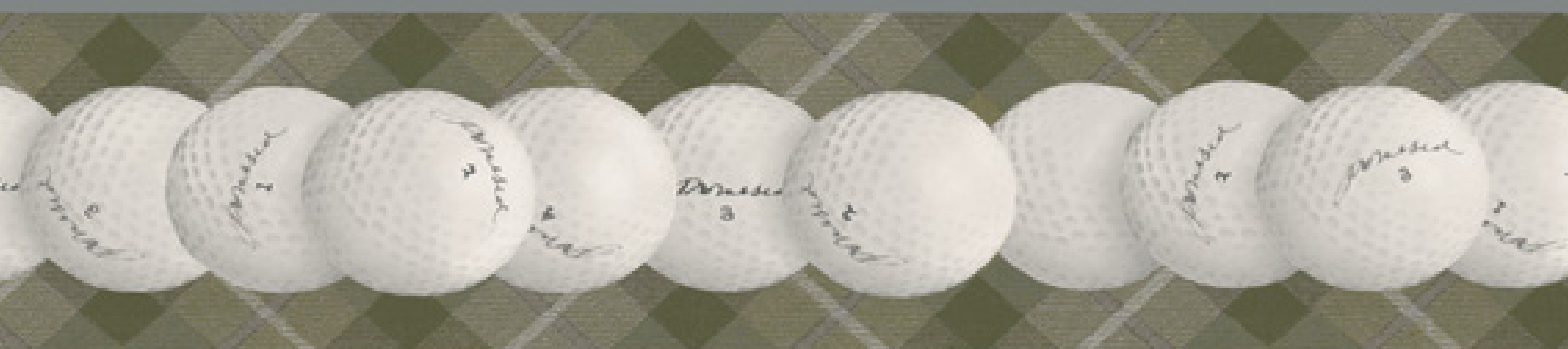
The Pool has been really busy this year and the addition of the new furniture and slide have received many positive remarks. In an effort to help the guards do the best job possible keeping everyone safe, please help keep inexperienced swimmers out of the areas where they can't touch. I've instructed the guards to test children who they feel should not be in the deep end by themselves without a life jacket. The test will consist of the life guard politely asking the children to swim from one side of the deep end to the other unassisted and to tread water for 15 seconds. If they can pass, they are more than welcome to use the diving board and to swim in those areas. The guards have also experienced several kids dunking each other on the slide or diving board and running on the pool deck. For their safety and the safety of everyone in or around the pool, please help us control these issues by speaking to your children on proper etiquette while at the pool. The main focus of the guards is to prevent water emergencies and provide a safe environment around the pool area.
