



Spring is here and everything is growing at a rapid rate, which is keeping us very busy in this early growing season. We hope to get some timely rainfalls that will be beneficial to the golf course. It has been a very dry season with our first rainfall coming in the middle of April.

We have been out spraying for Broadleaf weeds. Each year we are trying to improve more areas on the golf course. We also do this in the fall which this is a beneficial time also to apply the broadleaf application.

We have fixed numerous irrigation leaks around the golf course this spring and we are still currently addressing the seemingly ongoing problems throughout the season. With the age of our irrigation system problems are more likely to occur. We will keep up with the situations as they occur.

Diane has been doing a great job getting the greenhouse ready. With planting just around the corner all of the plants are looking great. A friendly reminder that the course work day will be on May 2<sup>nd</sup> and the sand and seed party will be May 18.

With finals fast approaching we will be back to full summer staff here on the course and we are looking forward to the upcoming season.
