A Letter from Our Golf Professional

Greetings Manhattan Country Club Members!

It's been a gorgeous fall season thus far and hopefully you've been able to get out and take advantage of the terrific weather!

With the month of November now upon us we are moving into the "off season" for golf. Beginning Monday, November 3rd, the Golf Course will be closed on Monday's until April 1st. Our apologies for any inconvenience that this may cause.

I've decided that periodically I will share a golf rule in my letter as a helpful reminder. BELOW YOU WILL SEE RULE 26-1 FROM THE USGA rules of golf. Rule 26-1 deals with taking relief from water hazards. as a reminder, yellow stakes are a "water hazard" and red stakes are a "lateral Water hazard":

26-1. Relief For Ball In Water Hazard

It is a question of fact whether a ball that has not been found after having been struck toward a <u>water hazard</u> (YELLOW STAKES) is in the <u>hazard</u>. In the absence of knowledge or virtual certainty that a ball struck toward a <u>water hazard</u>, but not found, is in the <u>hazard</u>, the player must proceed under Rule <u>27-1</u>.

If a ball is found in a <u>water hazard</u> or if it is known or virtually certain that a ball that has not been found is in the <u>water</u> <u>hazard</u> (whether the ball lies in water or not), the player may <u>under penalty of one stroke</u>:

- **a.** Proceed under the stroke and distance provision of Rule <u>27-1</u> by playing a ball as nearly as possible at the spot from which the original ball was last played (see Rule <u>20-5</u>); or
- **b.** Drop a ball behind the <u>water hazard</u>, keeping the point at which the original ball last crossed the margin of the <u>water</u> <u>hazard</u> directly between the <u>hole</u> and the spot on which the ball is dropped, with no limit to how far behind the <u>water</u> <u>hazard</u> the ball may be dropped; or
- **c.** As additional options available only if the ball last crossed the margin of a <u>lateral water hazard</u> (RED STAKES), drop a ball outside the <u>water hazard</u> within two club-lengths of and not nearer the <u>hole</u> than (i) the point where the original ball last crossed the margin of the <u>water hazard</u> or (ii) a point on the opposite margin of the <u>water hazard</u> equidistant from the <u>hole</u>. When proceeding under this Rule, the player may lift and clean his ball or <u>substitute</u> a ball.

Thanks for your time and I hope that you all have a great November!
