



Fall is quickly approaching and cooler temperatures are on their way! With the drop in temperatures we have finished our fall aerification and seeding program, and have completed the fall fertilization. The good weather has been very advantageous for our fall cultural practices, with the exception of #5 fairway and parts of #6 fairway, which were hit with a disease called Gray leaf spot. The other fairways did not seem to be affected as much.

The large amount of rainfall on hole number 5 stayed too saturated which created this situation. We have over seeded it again and are looking forward to better playing conditions on this hole. With the lower temperatures at night, please keep in mind that frost conditions will be fast approaching and we appreciate your patience during those times.

Going into October trees will begin shedding their leaves and we will do our best to maintain the golf course in a playable condition. We would like to thank Dianna Gebhardt for the wonderful job she did in putting on this year's Fall foliage tour. She has done a tremendous job again this year with the wonderful flower beds throughout the course.

Fall is a wonderful time so get out and enjoy this beautiful weather! Please remember that Mark's Revenge Tournament is scheduled for October 9th. We will have fun setting up the golf course for this fantastic event! If you have any questions or concerns please contact us.


