#### A Letter From Our Grounds Superintendent

September is here and with it comes some needed cooler weather. We plan to start over seeding the fairways and cool season tees starting as soon as possible, weather pending. We will be closing one hole at a time to complete the over seeding on that hole. This process is time consuming and we appreciate your cooperation.

Greens aerification will begin on Tuesday, September 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup>. We will be fertilizing greens a week before and directly after aerification to help promote a quick recovery during this process.

This year, as many of you have seen, we have been working on irrigation repairs. It seems as though every time one leak is fixed, another appears. Our system is old and built in the early 90's, but we are continuing to try and keep up on them.

Also with school starting our staff availability has changed. We are in the process of hiring a couple more part time employees to help out

during this busy fall season. With cooler weather this is one of the most enjoyable times to get out and golf. The flower beds on the course are looking spectacular this season.
