## MEMBERSHIP RE-CLASSIFICATION DEADLINE JULY 31

On April 8th at the monthly Arlington Board meeting it was voted unanimously to end the ongoing assessment that was created to capitalize the construction of our new clubhouse that encompasses the pro shop, golf locker rooms, cart storage, and the Colonel's Paddock Grill & Bar.

In discussions amongst the board it was decided to streamline our membership to where all members would belong to one of our current membership categories respective to their families needs. Over the last several years as our country faced tough economic challenges and the private club industry struggled Arlington was forced to use the assessment monies for general operations. As mentioned many factors contributed to this loss in club revenues but the biggest cause was our drop in overall memberships.

We all know hindsight is 20/20 and moving forward it is very important as a membership to agree to put the past behind us. This decision was made to unify our club and help grow our membership. An active, healthy, vibrant and strong membership allows for our operational expenses to be spread over a larger number of memberships therefore keeping monthly dues down as a whole. Again, it is important as a club of active and ever growing members we realize the need to move forward and streamline our membership into one of our current membership offerings.

For the most part this change will have minimal impact on the majority of our members monthly dues payment. In addition for members who have joined in the last several years you are most likely already enrolled into the current membership categories and will see virtually zero change in your membership dues.

**THE MEMBERSHIP RE-CLASSIFICATION DEADLINE is JULY 31st.** Over the next 90 days it will be each members responsibility to complete the membership re-classification form. This form will be mailed with the April, May and June statements. A link will also be available for print on Arlington-club.com and re-classification forms will be available for pick up in the pro shop and the Arlington House. Upon completion and receipt of the re-classification form the respective monthly membership fee will go into effect for each member.

**Any member not completing the re-classification form by the JULY 31st DEADLINE will be placed into the Full Family Membership category. It will be the clubs position to charge our highest monthly membership fee. The Arlington Club will not be responsible for assuming which membership re-classification category is best for you.**

## Membership Re-Classification FAQ's

- I just joined in 2014, Does this apply to my membership? No. Your Membership is up-to-date
- I pay the assessment annually and paid in full for 2014? A prorated refund will be posted to your account upon receiving your re-classification form.
- I paid the assessment up front and some members paid it monthly? By months end April 2014 each member will have paid almost to the penny the same principle amount.
- What about the interest that was to be paid by the members who choose the monthly assessment option? Very simply it was voted by the board to move forward and remove the assessment to streamline the membership and no interest will be collected. Again, as of month end April 2014 all members have paid the same amount in assessment fees whether it was upfront, monthly, or annually.
- I don't understand and need further clarification? In regards to completing the form the easiest train of thought will be to fill it out and examine the membership categories as if you were joining day one.
- I still don't get it...who do I talk to? Please contact and set up an appointment with Todd Christian, General Manager. Todd will be happy to address any concerns, answer questions, or discuss any details regarding The Arlington Club.
- I hate filling out forms...Can I do this online? The re-classification form can be printed online but must be completed and an actual hard copy returned to The Arlington Club.
- Where do I get the form? It will be in the next couple statement mailings, online, and available in the pro shop and the Arlington House.
- Why are we doing this again? Streamlining the membership prevents varying member dues for the same club amenities from one member to the next. It also brings the club a more uniformed dues structure aiding in membership growth.
- How do our dues compare to other private clubs locally and nationally? Both the Arlington board and KemperSports feel the dues structure is very competitive and offers strong value when comparing Arlington to other facilities.

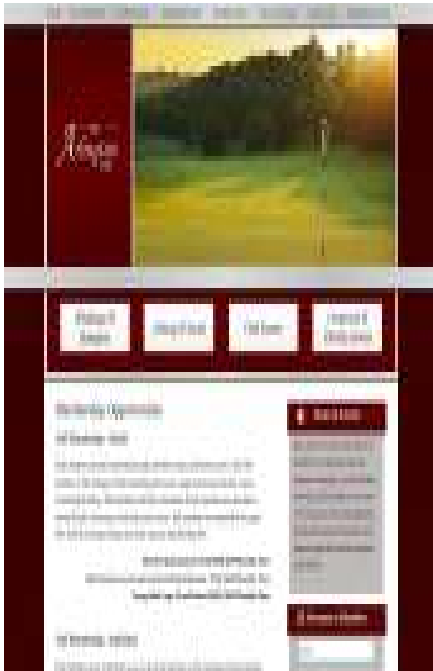
## Pool Opening Day Friday May 23rd
