## BY LAW CHANGE

Article 3 Section 1B: Applicants must have a USGA GHIN number of 40.4. If the applicant does not have a USGA GHIN number, they shall submit attested 18 hole score cards for rounds completed on rated courses to support the handicap limitation.

It was moved by Luann Penner that we strike Article 3 Section 1B, 2nd by Joan Heeter and approved by majority (26 to 5) after much discussion which included the following: Should we have a limit? High handicaps slow down play--they should pick up after 10 strokes. People with similar handicaps should play together. We like the mixing of handicaps to play with different people. Shouldn't we state they need a USGA GHIN? When the player joins that includes the USGA GHIN. OGA wants to grow the game and we shouldn't do anything to hinder this growth.

Valerie Spirit moved that Article 3 Section 1B go to the Board for a revision. It was 2nd by Janet Elliott and passed unanimously.
