#### WE NEED YOUR EMAIL!!

With the upcoming GHIN platform changeover, one of the major things being addressed is privacy. In order to protect **your** information, your account on GHIN will be protected using a combination of your  ${\it GHIN\,\#\,and\,your\,email\,address.}\ Once the new\,{\it GHIN\,platform\,is\,up\,and\,running,\,expected\,to\,be\,this}$ spring, each person will set up a profile. We'll keep you posted on when that will occur.

Each individual needs their own unique email that must not be shared with another person. For example, if a wife and husband share one email, BOTH emails will be purged from GHIN and neither person will be able to use the shared email.

- > With a unique email and active OGA membership/GHIN #:
  - o You will be able to post online and look up your information on GHIN.com
  - You will be able to log in and use the GHIN Mobile App
  - o You will be able to post on the computer at the course
- > If you do not have a unique email address:
  - $\circ\quad$  The ONLY place you will be able to post your scores is on the computer at a Golf Course
