
## It's Tournament Time!

# How to post scores when playing match play

The game of golf is based on the premise that a player will play as well as the player can play. Under the USGA Handicap System, each player is required to record a hole score for a hole not finished, not played or not played under the Rules of Golf, and to reduce any hole score when it is higher than the maximum number allowed under Equitable Stroke Control.

### Unfinished Holes and Conceded Strokes

A player who starts but does not complete a hole or is conceded a stroke must record the most likely score for handicap purposes. The most likely score may not exceed the player's Equitable Stroke Control limit. This most likely score should be preceded by an "X". (Most likely score is a judgment that each player must make based on the player's own game. It consists of the number of strokes already taken plus, in the player's best judgment, the number of strokes needed to complete the hole from that position more than half the time. The player must evaluate each situation based on what the player can reasonably expect to score.)

There is no limit to the number of unfinished holes a player may have in a round, provided that failure to finish is not for the purpose of handicap manipulation.

# Equitable Stroke Control

All scores for handicap purposes, including tournament scores, are subject to the application of Equitable Stroke Control (ESC). This mandatory procedure reduces high hole scores for handicap purposes in order to make handicaps more representative of a player's potential ability.

ESC is used when a player's actual or most likely score exceeds a maximum number, based on the following table, for the player's "Course Handicap" from the tees played.
