This event will be an 18 hole 4-man scramble with breakfast preceding the golf.


The Kick-Off event is open to any member of the Lake Valley Men's Golf Association. Cost for Kick


Highway Sign Fundraiser

1 Qt. water

4 cubes chicken bouil-

1 cup diced celery

1 cup diced onion

2 ½ cups peeled, diced potatoes

1 – 20 oz. bag of frozen mixed vegetables

1 – 16 oz. Velveeta cheese

1 can cream of chicken soup

Combine water, bouillon, celery and onion in large pot and cook for 20 minutes. Add potatoes, vegetables and cook an additional 30 minutes. Add soup and cheese and heat until cheese is melted. Enjoy
