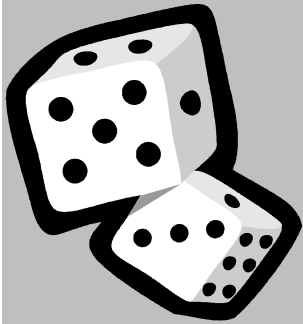
GOLF NEWS
