

2019 Chapman Best Ball Open

Saturday, June 8, 2019

Rules of Play

- Within each four person team, the players will split into 2 two-person chapman teams. The chapman pairings will remain the same for the entire 18-hole round.
- Each chapman team will produce a single score on each hole and the best score of the two chapman scores will be the team's score for that hole gross and net.
- Chapman Handicap is computed by taking 60% of the A player course handicap plus 40% of the B players course handicap.
- As in a regular best ball event, any ball that will not count as the team's score does not need to be holed out.

Chapman Rules

- Each player hits a drive. Each player then hits his partner's second shot. At this point, the ball in the best position is chosen and holed out in an alternate shot format.
- Summer Rules
- Men will play from the green tees. Women will play from the silver tees. Senior men (60+) may play from the silver tees. Senior women (60+) may play the gold tees. Please make sure the golf shop is aware of which tee you are playing prior to teeing off.
- Rules questions or situations while on the course, please play two balls. Be sure to get the correct ruling before signing your scorecard.
