Course Update for Spring 2023

As we turn the conversation to course conditioning, I would like to update everyone on what has been happening over the last couple of months regarding course improvements and maintenance activities here at Sudden Valley Golf Club.

November:

- We started tackling the blackberries that have been overtaking various areas throughout the front nine holes along Austin creek.
- Started annual equipment maintenance.
- Started vegetation control and cleanup of 15 tee box complex.

December:

- Began aggressively aerating and topdressing all the fairways, high traffic areas throughout the course.
- Started construction of four forward Gold tee boxes.
- Annual maintenance conducted on all Irrigation satellite boxes throughout the course.
- Continued Fairway aerating and sand topdressing.

January:

- More work on blackberries mowing them down with a rented flail mower.
- Cleaned out drainage ditch along #1 fairway.
- Removed and installed new section of 10" drain line on #1 that was completely plugged with Willow tree roots.

February:


- Began tree work on the course. Limbing up trees behind #15 green to introduce more light and air flow through the winter and early spring.
- Limbing up trees along #3/5/9
- Again, more aerating and sand topdressing throughout the course.
- The sodding of new Gold tee boxes completed, with the expectation of opening up for play in late May.

March:

- Began draining #4 pond in anticipation of removing "cattail" growth this spring.
- All tee boxes were aerated, overseeded and a healthy dose of lime followed by sand topdressing.
- Wrapping up sprinkler head/drainage box clearing for the upcoming season.
- Began pressurizing irrigation system for upcoming season to ensure any leaks are repaired.

Which brings us to our upcoming season. I am very pleased to say that with all the hard work that the dedicated grounds crew completed, the start of this 2023 season should be off to a great start.
