Rules and Etiquette

Pace of Play and Reaching Your Max Score on a Hole

If you are not in a competition and find that your group is falling behind, a good practice is when you reach your maximum score, pick up and move on to the next hole.

Your max on any hole is *net par plus 2*. That translates to par, plus your handicap strokes plus two additional strokes, e.g. if you get one handicap stroke (pop) on a par 4, then your max score on that hole would be 7 - par 4 + 1 handicap stroke + 2 additional strokes.

Local Rule on Holes 7 and 9

Remember, when you hit your ball into the creek on hole 7 or 9, you also have an option to hit from the other side of the creek as long as you are no closer to the pin. Rather then just dropping another ball and risk going into the creek a second time, you have the option to cross the bridge and drop the ball on the left side of cart path as long as you are no closer to the pin.
