# Do You Know? Rules and Etiquette

## **Posting Your Score**

#### When You Must Post a Score

- All rounds played under the Rules of Golf should be posted (unless specifically excluded below).
- 9-hole or 18-hole rounds both count (the system combines 9-hole scores).
- Stroke play, match play, tournament, or casual rounds all count if played under the Rules of Golf.
- Rounds with fewer than 18 holes completed: You may still post if at least 7 holes are played for a 9-hole score, or 14 holes for an 18-hole score (with net par used for unplayed holes).
- Scores from any course with a valid Course Rating™ and Slope Rating® (anywhere in the world) are acceptable.



#### When Not to Post a Score

You should not post scores if:

- You played fewer than 7 holes (for a 9-hole score) or fewer than 14 holes (for an 18-hole score).
- You used non-conforming clubs, balls, or equipment.
- You did not play under the Rules of Golf.
- You played alone (a score must be played with at least one other person under WHS).
- The course was not rated by a governing golf association.
- You practiced or played a round where you intentionally didn't hole out.
- Conditions were abnormal and the round wasn't played the way the course is designed (e.g., winter rules with mats in fairways, temporary greens not rated, etc.).



## **Key Posting Rules**

- Maximum Hole Score: Use Net Double Bogey as the maximum score allowed on any hole for handicap posting purposes.
- Post the same day you play (WHS updates daily).
- Match Play: Even if a hole is conceded, record your most likely score for posting.
- Incomplete Holes: If you start a hole but don't finish, you must post your most likely score (within the Rules of Handicapping)
